GUIDELINES FOR GRAND ASSEMBLY

May 5, 2021

Dear Rainbow Girls and Adults,

Registration

- Available space and seating is critical. This event is by invitation only.
- Availability is on a first come, first served basis.
- Attendance will be limited in line with the State of Michigan guidelines
- Everyone must pre-register – there will be no walk-ins accepted
- There will be no Pledge Girls at this meeting
- There will be no children at this meeting

Health and Safety

- The building will be completely sanitized before and after the meeting
- Everyone will have a health screening and a temperature check, if indicated. Contact tracing will be done.
- Everyone must maintain a social distancing of 6' apart
- Masks must be worn indoors except for eating. Masks must be worn outdoors if not social distancing
- Please bring your own mask (but disposable masks will be available if forgotten)
- Hand sanitizer will be widely available.
- Hand washing in restrooms will be for 20 seconds.
- Pens, notebooks, clothing, food or beverages cannot be shared.
- All hugs, handshakes are prohibited.
- Additional permission slips for these circumstances are required as previously distributed.

Dress Code

- Remember to bring your mask and aprons
- There is limited changing space. This space will be monitored and regulated.
- Personal items and clothing must be contained and not scattered about the rooms
- All Grand Officers should arrive in their white business suits and they will be wearing the suits for the entire day.
- All Grand Representatives should arrive in their white formal for the day.
- Endorsees not currently in the Grand Family should bring their white formal with them.
- All other Rainbow Girls should wear business dress/skirt.
- Changing space for adults is limited to those in the Installation.
- All adult women are asked to wear business/summer dresses/skirts (no slacks/shorts).
- Gentlemen are welcome to wear dress slacks and polo shirts.

Miscellaneous

- Saturday Night Packets and t-shirts will be distributed in the parking lot after Installation. This is for crowd control and to encourage social distancing
- The Mother Advisor of each Assembly will receive all packets for the Assembly. This includes packets for Grand Officers, Grand Representatives and other State Officials. The Mother Advisor can then distribute the packets in different sections of the parking lot.

I know there are a lot more questions and some of them we still do not have answers for. As you know, this is only the second time we have done this version and it keeps changing. Questions are most certainly welcomed, and more information will be distributed as it becomes available. Patience will be a virtue that day as we all cope with something different. There will be many jobs that we will need help with, and I hope, if you are able to, you will say yes when asked to help. Some of these guidelines may change as vaccination levels change.

I am asking that each of you girls, parents and adults make your own clear informed decision about attending the 2021 Grand Assembly of Michigan.
