been extremely fast. It is already November and Christmas is right around the corner. They say that as you get older time goes by faster and I believe that, but even my kids say that time flies! I guess we are all just having fun.

We have started to offer a few in-person programs here at the library. Story time with Mrs. Susan started back in September with a limit of ten children. We are asking for parents to call and sign up so we know how many take and make crafts to prepare ahead of time and also to let us know if we need to have more than one session of story time for social distancing purposes. Mrs. Susan does a fabulous job getting kids excited about reading. Call and sign up especially since we are getting closer to the holidays. It will be much fun.

We are teaming up with Martin Methodist College on November 12th at 5:00 p.m. for a Zoom Virtual Author Event with Homer Hickam. Mr. Hickam is the best-selling author of his memoir Rocket Boys and a number of other books as well. Rocket Boys was made into the movie October Sky. Homer Hickam has been a Vietnam combat veteran, a coal miner, a scuba instructor, NASA engineer, paleontologist, and a best-selling author. It has two age groups and each age group meets virtually via Zoom every other week. It is a wonderful way for kids to have fun and they don't realize they are learning so much. We are having the Family Keepsake Christmas Plate program again this year from December 14 through December 19 here at the library. We are spreading it out over a week instead of doing it in one day. 



Homer Hickam's short article about his life as a young boy growing up in Coalwood, WV and aspiring to be a rocket scientist was called "The Big Creek Missile Agency" and was written for Air & Space Magazine in 1994. It received so much acclaim and interest, he was asked to write a book detailing the whole was asked to write a book detailing the whole story. Rocket Boys: A Memoir was published by Delacorte Press in September 1998 and the movie based on it, October Sky premiered nationwide on his birthday February 19, 1999. The title of the paperback released at the same time was changed to the movie title, which is an ANAGRAM of Rocket Boys (take the letters of rocket boys and move them around to spell october sky!)


