Quarterly, upon recommendation of the commission, the State shall pay in the manner prescribed by law to the city, village or township in which a full-time police department or full-time ordinance enforcement department is maintained, and where a police department or full-time ordinance enforcement department is not maintained, then to the counties, to be credited to the sheriff's department in which the license is located 55% of the amount of the proceeds of the retailers' license fees collected therein, for the specific purpose of enforcing this Act and the rules of the commission.
