Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the motion to approve today's agenda and the minutes from August 22 with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. All in favor, motion carried.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented BRO-docs already approved by MODOT to be signed by Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll.

SB190 was discussed again with the Commission still taking it under advisement.

At 10 a.m. the Commission set the county levy at .1232 unchanged from 2022. County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented the current valuation for DeKalb County and requested the levy to remain the same as was presented in 2022. The current valuation is 231,831,997 up by 42,551 from 2022. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve setting the levy at .1232 Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the second. All in favor, motion carried.

Grand River Township Board Member, Mark Robinson met with the Commission to discuss a cooperative agreement between the County and Township.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll followed up on a phone call concerning brush on Thornton Rd. The road in question had been addressed by a previous complaint, and a brush letter has been issued.

A reminder that now only 1 brush letter will be sent to property owners, but that letter allows up to 6 months for the brush to be eradicated.

September 21st is the next meeting of the NW Commissioner's which will be held in Grundy County.

Maysville Homecoming will be held September 22 with activities planned on the Courthouse lawn and steps.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission to discuss brush, work being done around the County and equipment purchase.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn until September 5, 2023. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second to adjourn. All in favor, motion carried.
