### A Note from Pastor Toni

YUMC's mission statement says that we are a church committed to <u>BRING PEOPLE TO THE TRANSFORMING</u>
<u>POWER IN JESUS CHRIST</u>. One of the primary operative words in this statement is the word BRING!

It's the most wonderful time of the year! It's Christmas—a time when most of us actually choose to enter into the crazy, frenetic, busyness of the holiday. Gift buying, wrapping, parties, food, drinks, and desserts; more food and drinks and desserts, travel, guests, family visits, cooking, cleaning... STOP!



Meeting on the second Thursday of each month except for this month!




Our December Read will be:

One reader's analysis:

This is a "must read" novel for anyone interested in the 1850's westward journey to reach California and Oregon over the historical Oregon Trail. The pioneers risked everything to make it there and the courage, strength and determination they had to have is an astonishing accomplishment.

Jane Kirkpatrick weaves a grand story based on a true accounting by Ezra Meeker in his 1852 journal. It notes his profound impression of a small group of covered wagons reaching their destination along the Trail. In disbelief, he observes that there were no men in this group of 11 women and children. All the men had died along the way, leaving the women to fend for themselves. Based on this recollection, Ms. Kirkpatrick reveals obvious historical research to enhance the story line and satisfy those historically hungry readers with accurate representations of life along the trail.




## News Flash!!

From the Leadership Board for December 2019. . . .

**Sunday worship services.** We've noticed that the "vibe" on Sundays has been incredibly positive the last month since the Charge Conference. We hope you've felt it too. Keep it rolling !! Pastor Toni has made some changes which we hope you are enjoying. The Leadership Team (LT) has no direct influence on the services. We respect, and encourage you to respect, that Pastor Toni spends two days a week in preparation for what is her special time on Sunday mornings. If you like the service, let her know. Thank you also to our new Worship Team Leader Leah Young for her contributions. Human nature being what it is, come next July we may well be observing/complaining that "it's not like it used to be". So enjoy what each day brings.

Leadership Team changes. The LT has created a new position for Jennifer Villani: Adult Ministries. She'll be the direct liaison between all the adult ministries and the LT. Under the traditional style of church governance these ministries had a seat and vote on the LT which is not present in the streamlined system. The LT encourages all the participants in adult ministries to let Jennifer know what you think, feel and need.

The LT has also created a new position for Kelly Atchley: Children & Youth Ministries Liaison. Among her other responsibilities she'll be organizing a program for children grade 1 through 5 to supplement our outstanding IMPACT program for teenagers.

Church potluck and "Building" event February 2020. Instead of a Friday evening and Saturday day event the LT is changing it to a Saturday (only) event, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. with food!! Some topics for our discussion include fundraising events for the whole church, joint activities with other churches in the area, reviving the Parents Night Out program, and whatever YOU want to talk about.

**FY 2020 budget.** The FY 2020 is currently being evaluated by the LT. It will be a six month budget because the salary and benefit package for the new minister may be different than our present costs.

**Homeless.** Deb and Pete Bein are leading a discussion with the Beacon of Hope program to use our facilities for two nights per week to provide a meal and shelter for the homeless.

Current budget shortfall. We are still running a deficit in excess of \$10,000. We are not exceeding our budgeted expenses but rather are "light" on giving. Help as you can.

Complaints and suggestions. Calling the church office Monday morning is not nearly as effective as writing a short/long note to the Leadership Team to be discussed by the whole team at their monthly meeting. Better yet, write the note then come in person; we have moved member comments to the start of the monthly meeting agenda. The Leadership Team works on your behalf but can't address problems that you keep to yourself.
