The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall.

Mayor Lentz called the meeting to order.

Present: Mayor Lentz and Commissioners Forkenbrock, Edwards, Krug and Barton. Also present was Kim Clausen.

Mayor Lentz provided the current status of the pool to a crowd of citizens. He told the citizens that the cost to repair the current pool and shower house would be over \$100,000. He informed them the cities insurance company approved an extension for the city to open the pool for one more year since there are talks of building a new pool. The insurance company would like the city to do only the repairs necessary, and not dump a lot of money into a pool that is going to be open for only one more year. The Commission also shared what it costs for the city to operate the pool on a yearly basis.

There are several local investors that have showed interest in footing the cost of a new pool, but there are still several questions unanswered at this point to know if it is even possible. The Commissioners were left with the task of meeting with the city attorney and speaking with the cities financial advisor to find out the legalities. Mayor Lentz reminded the crowd again that the city will not have the funds to build a pool next year either and that without the help the city would be without a pool.

Motion by Commissioner Edwards to adjourn at 7:02 p.m. Seconded by Commissioner Barton. All aye.
