Note: An entry in any of the events is considered a 'First Entry.' Entering any other event is NOT a 'Second Entry.' i.e. Rally & Obedience are separate events. For example, if Dog A is entered in Open Dog, Stud Dog, Obedience Open A, & Rally Novice A, his total entry fees would be \$124. (\$32 + \$28 + \$32 + \$32) Dog A is entered in both Open & Stud Dog in Conformation, therefore Stud Dog is an Additional Entry. The Obedience & Rally classes are each considered First Entries.

*** Brace class is considered a unit. Only one dog in a Brace is required to pay the class fee, and since both dogs MUST be entered in other classes, it would be an Additional Entry.*

Amateur-Owner-Handler (AOH Class Eligibility): For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age or older as of the first day of this show, that are not Champions of Record. Dogs must be handled in the class by a registered owner of the dog, and this class is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. (effective 1-1-09)

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE Class Eligibility): The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are six (6) months of age or older as of the first day of this show, that are not Champions of Record, who are individually registered with the American Kennel Club and are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders as of the date of closing entries for this show. The person handling the dog in this class must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle

Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Also, dogs that, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose records are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championship is unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date when the dog completed the requirements for a championship, according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until his championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

SAME CLASSES FOR DOGS AND BITCHES

The first place Winner of each of these classes, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed

Veteran Classes

7 years and under 10 years 10 years and older

Under 'AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows,' Chapter 11, Section 8, Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

Lure Coursing Classes This class is open only to those Basenjis that have received a title from any recognized Lure Coursing organization, such as: AKC, ASFA, & CKC.

However, dogs with JC title only are not eligible. Entrants may NOT be spayed or neutered. This class will be judged according to the AKC breed standard.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Judging will be based on merits of the Get. Although the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its' disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed. GET MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, BEST OF BREED OR SOME OTHER NON-REGULAR CLASS OTHER THAN STUD DOG.

The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes at a first entry fee of \$32.00, with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form in the Additional Class field at an additional cost of \$28.00, OR, the Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog class only for a fee of \$32.00.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as for Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

'AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows,' Chapter 11, Section 8, provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and spayed bitches may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class: Each Brace shall be composed of **2 Basenjis**, irrespective of sex, that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by one, or a maximum of two, handler(s). Both dogs comprising the Brace must have at least one common owner and must be entered in another Regular or Non-Regular class. An entry form for a dog entered in the Brace Class must indicate the name of the other dog comprising the other half of the brace.

Brace Entry fee is \$28.00 for the unit. For each dog entered in the Brace Class, indicate 'Brace' in the Additional Entry field of the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by an identical owner, the dog comprising each Brace Unit must be designated as "Brace #1" and "Brace #2", Etc, Entry fee is for each Brace, not each individual dog.

A Brace is defined by AKC as: "Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the Brace competition must have at least one common owner."

As the judge's decisions in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace classes are based on more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

BEST PUPPY COMPETITION: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-by Exhibitor from the Bred-by Exhibitor winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed competition, unless the Best Bred-by Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-by Exhibitor Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-by Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-by Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

BEST VETERAN COMPETITION: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran Class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

GRAND CHAMPION POINTS
Grand Championship points will be awarded to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

3 POINT MAJOR RESERVE
At the National Specialty, dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner’s sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

JUDGE’S AWARD OF MERIT
Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at his discretion, up to 10 of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition. These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/Bitch or Best of Winners.

This means Exhibitors/Dog Owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs on the show grounds – including the ring – and everywhere at their hotel. Non-compliance will be reported. Consequences may include a Bench Show Committee hearing and/or hotel expulsion.

Entrants in the Amateur Owner Handler class will be automatically entered in this competition.

There is no additional fee for this competition.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

GENERAL OBEDIENCE & RALLY ENTRY RULES & INFORMATION

- The term "dog" refers to either dog or bitch in both Obedience and Rally.
- Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes. Qualifying scores are not required for prizes in Non-Regular classes.
- Non-Regular & Titling classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial Championships.
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS.
- A refund of all but \$2.00 of the entry fee will be made to any exhibitor who has a bitch entered in the Obedience Trial or Rally Trial who comes into season after the close of entries. Handlers wishing refunds must present a veterinarian's certification to the Show Secretary no later than a half hour before the event on the day that dog is entered.

PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

THERE ARE NO RESTRICTIONS TO HANDLERS IN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee is \$28.00 The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Basenjis, 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. ALL SWEEPSTAKES ENTRANTS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR BREED CLASS. Entry fee is in addition to the Regular Class entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular classes. The Sweepstakes class should be entered in the Additional Class field with the age division noted on the same entry form used to enter the dog or bitch in a Regular Class.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee is \$28.00. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Basenjis, seven (7) years of age and older on the day of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Breed Class. If this is the only class in which the dog is entered, indicate 'Veteran Sweepstakes' with the age division noted in the Dog Show Class field. If it is an additional class, indicate 'Veteran Sweepstakes' with the age division noted in the Additional Class field.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. However, sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the show as a result of participating in the Veteran Sweepstakes.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

After 35% of the entry fee is retained by BCOA to cover expenses,
the balance in each class will be distributed as follows:

First Prize	40% of the balance of the entry fees for that class
Second Prize	30% of the balance of the entry fees for that class
Third Prize	20% of the balance of the entry fees for that class
Fourth Prize	10% of the balance of the entry fees for that class

All monetary prizes not awarded will be retained by the Club.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the AKC National Championship competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry on the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

GENERAL RULES FOR JR. SHOWMANSHIP

- At a Specialty show, each dog in Junior Showmanship must be of the breed for which that show is held.
- BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.
- Dogs shown must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler, or by a member of their family.
- A dog other than the one entered may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. The Junior must have the AKC number of the substitute dog. All such substitutions must be made with the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show.
- AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club by calling: (919) 816-3776.

Color Genetics & Genetic Diversity

Dayna Dreger, PhD

Dayna Dreger, PhD is a canine geneticist at Purdue University College of Veterinary Medicine. She completed her graduate studies with Dr. Sheila Schmutz, a forerunner of canine pigmentation genetics, at the University of Saskatchewan. She then studied under Dr. Elaine Ostrander, a distinguished investigator and preeminent leader in the field of dog genetic research. Presently in the lab of Dr. Kari Ekenstedt, she is involved in research to identify causal genetic variants and risk factors associated with a range of dog traits, including skeletal malformations, breed relatedness, and ocular diseases. Herself an avid dog owner, trainer, competitor, and judge, she is in a unique position to merge the insights and knowledge of the vast community of dog enthusiasts with advanced research methodologies. As such, she is equally committed to bringing the science back to the people that will use it, presenting seminars on relevant breed-specific findings to breed and kennel clubs across the US and Canada.

Dr. Dreger will discuss the most recent understanding of dog color genetics, as they function across breeds, but specifically related to Basenjis. She will share new findings on the measurable genetic ancestry of the Basenji, and the current measures of genetic diversity of the breed. She will outline current research projects and detail how the Basenji can contribute to our understanding of spine development and neurological health in dogs.

Another way to support the National is to pledge items for our Raffle. This year we are offering a judged competition for baskets contributed by BCOA affiliated Basenji Clubs from across the country. Each submittal should be designed to portray some aspect of the territory of the contributing Club. Again, they can be pledged, as above, or transported to the National by an exhibitor. All items will be on display near ringside, each day until the drawing, which will occur during the Lunch break for Conformation judging on Thursday.

ADDITIONAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Old Pueblo Hall will be locked between 9:00 pm and 6:00 am each day. There is no overnight security in the building.
2. All vehicles must stay on the roads or within the designated parking areas when driving near the grass area to the south and west of Old Pueblo Hall. **Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed on the grass field.**
3. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times. Dogs and exhibitors must be removed from all buildings within one hour following Best in Show each day.
4. When using the unloading zone, flashers or headlights MUST remain on.
5. Dogs are not allowed to be left out at night in exercise pens or crates anywhere on the show grounds after 11:00 pm.
6. Good sportsman-like conduct extends to the unloading zones too! Abuse of parking privileges can result in a Bench Show hearing.
7. Action can and will be taken to rescue any animal or child in distress that is confined in a vehicle. All vehicle owners on the show premises automatically waive their rights to legal action or damages regarding any animal or child in distress that is confined in a vehicle.
8. All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the Basenji Club of America, Inc. or the Pima County Fairgrounds, or their members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue any animal or child in distress.
9. Anyone requesting overnight RV handicapped parking must have a valid Handicap permit or plate. The Pima County Fairgrounds facility is handicap accessible. With their new online RV Parking Reservation Process, you can choose the zone that will best suit your individual needs. Handicap Parking does not mean "Near the Rings," it means an accessible surface and space.
10. The Basenji Club of America, Inc. will enforce the Arizona & Pima County Leash laws. Having a dog at large or roaming is a misdemeanor under Arizona law. Your dog must be kept in an enclosed area when on the property. Tie outs are prohibited. Even if the dog causes no harm, the law says it should be restrained by a leash when in public. The Pima County Fairgrounds, the Southwestern Fair Commission, Inc. and the Basenji Club of America, Inc. will enforce the Arizona/Pima County leash laws.
11. Retractable Leads are dangerous to use in crowded or confined areas, such as those that occur around the show rings. Because of this danger, retractable leads are forbidden on the show grounds during show hours.
12. No crates or exercise pens will be allowed within 20 feet of any ring.
13. In the designated Grooming Areas access to electrical plugs is not exclusive and is not reserved.
14. Each exhibitor is responsible for clean-up in and around their set-up area.
15. There are designated areas on the grass for the erection of portable shade tenting. Tents should be located so as to not block access to rings or other exhibitor's set-ups.
16. The Pima County Fairgrounds, the Southwest Fair Commission, Inc. and the Basenji Club of America, Inc., their officers and members, will not, under any circumstances, assume responsibility for the safety and/or care of any dogs during the night or for the loss of or damage to any personal property.
17. No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted to operate inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent or structure in which this dog show is conducted.
18. The Basenji Club of America, Inc. is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.
19. The Pima County Fairgrounds holds a #6 Liquor License.
20. Parents or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
21. Declination of entries. The Basenji Club of America, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

There is a \$2.00 Event Services Fee for the 4-6 Month Puppy Competition. There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2).

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: Cheryl Cazier, 2926 N 34 Pl, Phoenix AZ 85018. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS** make fees payable in **U.S. FUNDS. NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$30.00 collection fee. The returned check and fee must be paid with CASH at the Show Secretary's desk or office **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring. **No post-dated checks** will be accepted. **FAX, TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.**

ONLINE ENTRIES MUST have entry fees paid simultaneously, and prior to the closing date and time, by credit card, debit card or PayPal. Otherwise, entries will not be accepted.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. **NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made. **ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & Judging Program will be mailed within 1 week after the close of entries. Judging program will be emailed to all entrants & available online. If you don't receive a mailed Entry Confirmation by 7 days prior to the show, please notify the Show Secretary, ShowsbyCheryl@gmail.com or 602-885-2165.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING. DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused. This show is unbenched.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over. **ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG SHOWS** hereby waive any claim for damages against the Basenji Club of America, and/or its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. **THE CLUB, ITS SHOW SECRETARY, THE PIMA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, the HOTEL** or any employees thereof will not be responsible for the loss of or injury to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes.
