

Walking the Walk

Romans 12:1-3 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think [of himself] more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

I.) It's only through Christ we can obtain holiness. I am responsible for spiritual growth and prayerfulness.

A.) I Corinthians 1: 26-31

1.) The Lord is able to give us the strength to be “holy”, or “sanctified”. Ephesians 3:14-21

2.) I must pursue Holiness. Hebrews 12:14

3.) I must put away “old” things” Eph 4:17-32

4.) I must seek peace. Ephesians 4:1-5

B.) It is my responsibility to keep my prayer life alive. Jude 16-20

C.) It is my responsibility to seek the Holy Spirit and to walk in Him.

I Corinthians 14:15

What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

II.) Love toward God and trust Christ for our salvation

A.) It is my responsibility to please God through my faith. Jude 21

Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

B.) I am the only thing that can keep me from the love of God.

Romans 8:38-39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

III.) Activity in soul winning.

A.) I am the only “Jesus” some will ever know! *JUDE 1:22 Be merciful to those who doubt;*

C.) I can’t be afraid to tell the truth about sin, no matter how “Scary” it might be. *23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.*

D.) I can handle my duties because he can handle me! I will praise Him in faith believing His word! *24* Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

25 To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever. Amen.
