

Jacobi, LaVerne H.

LaVerne H. "Vern" Jacobi, 82, of Sandusky passed away Wednesday, Aug. 13, 2008 at William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak after a brief illness.

LaVerne was born Nov. 16, 1925 in Adair to the late LaVerne (Doc) and Valray (Draves) Jacobi. He married Laurelie Dutcher on Jan. 29, 1949 in Juhl, Michigan.

Mr. Jacobi owned and operated Doc's Super Service in Sandusky for many years. He was a member of the Sandusky Presbyterian Church. Vern retired from the Sandusky Fire Department after many years of service. He was a member of the Caseville Eagles. He also served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII and was a member of the Sandusky VFW No. 2945 and American Legion.
