Following the service, a procession will lead to the Memorial for the Unborn at Mount Calvary Catholic Cemetery. Beginning at 1:00pm, church bells across the state of Utah will ring for 29 minutes or 1,746 seconds. Each second will represent one of the babies lost to abortion since the injunction.
- * **January 28th:** Respect for the Dignity of Life Day at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church in Sandy from 9:00am-Noon. Mass will begin at 9:00am followed by discussions on Human Dignity and Building a Culture of Life, Mental Health Awareness: Accompanying those who suffer, and The Joshua Project-Raising up Joshua's through outreach to the youth of the diocese.
