Amana Explores Need for Fire Station Addition

Growing needs and modern fire-fighting tactics have meant that the present Amana Firehouse located in Middle Amana is too small to house the vehicles and equipment required to fight fires in our community; is the conclusion of the Amana Fire District Board of Trustees.

Steve Rose, Treasurer for the Board of Trustees of the Amana Fire District, explained Friday in an informal conversation, that the taxes raised to pay for building upkeep, equipment maintenance and new equipment via our property taxes are stretched very thin. Even replacing vital O2 breathing equipment requires budget planning and fund raising. In the past 5 years, the need for more space to house emergency vehicles has led volunteers to discuss and think ahead about how best to meet that need.

Now the fire department is asking the community to help as they begin a fund raising campaign to add space to the fire house by building an addition.

Two public open houses are being held so that residents may learn more and ask questions.

Stop by the Middle Amana firehouse anytime between 1 and 3 p.m. on Sunday, April 27 or Tuesday, April 29 between 5 and 7 p.m. Informational talks will be held every 30 minutes or so. Prior to his current role, Davidson was a middle school principal in Fort Dodge, as well as a PK-6th grade principal in Pocahontas CSD. Earlier in his career, he was a health, social studies, and science teacher, and he also has experience as a baseball, basketball, and football coach.

The new door would be the exact same 36” with 75” rough opening. Replace the attic windows with vinyl. The current window is 30X36 (note: Upper part of the 9/6 is used for attic ventilation). Install white aluminum wrap on fascia board and roof overhang.
 - b. 2025-015 Ryan & Lyndsey McCarty /Middle Amana Granary Barn / HP-A/ Replace wooden windows with new wooden windows. Repair sandstone foundation with reclaimed sandstone. Replace wooden cupola trim with unpainted original cedar wood lap siding. Replace galvanized panels on roof where needed with new galvanized sheeting. Power wash the entire roof and apply a galvanized coat.
 - c. 2025-019 Jeff Davis /3146 Hwy 6 Trail Homestead/ HP-C/ Rezoning permit: Rezone property from commercial to residential contingent on sale of property. Currently zoned commercial as AJ’s Copper.
 - d. 2025-006 Aaron & Shana Schaefer /5204 C St East Amana/ HP-R/GRANT APPLICATION: Replace existing wood lamp post with new high density polymer post on front (north) side of property. Existing lantern will be re-used. Install 2 new high density polymer posts and new brass lanterns on either side of the walkway at the south entrance of the property between the house and the garage. Lamps and post ordered through Amana Service company.
 - e. 2025-007 Tyler Stockman & Allison Momany /HP-R/ GRANT APPLICATION: Replace gutters with 6” half-round seamless aluminum with galvanized pattern. Replace downspouts with 4” seamless aluminum with galvanized pattern.
 - f. 2025-008 Lisa Lammey /606 13th Ave. High Amana/ HP-R/ GRANT APPLICATION: Replace roof on house with gray asphalt shingles. Install ice/water protection on eaves and valleys. Replace all flashings as needed on roof and chimney.

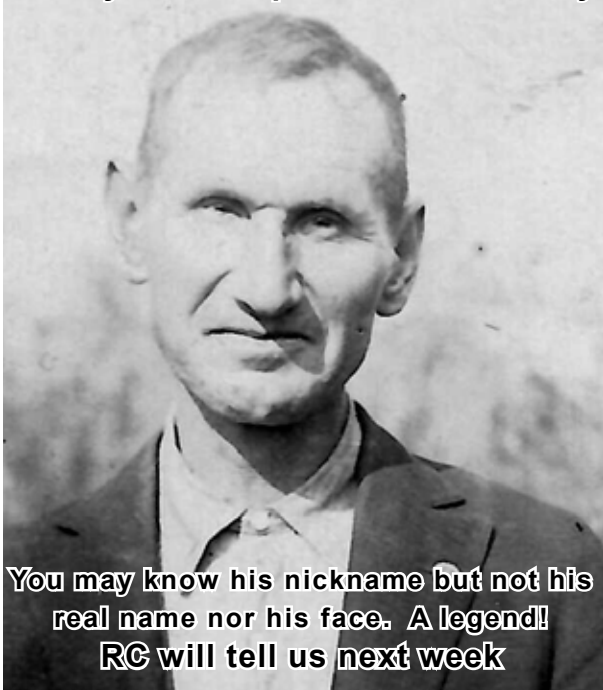
