



FISHING GUIDELINES

FISHING LICENSE: No fishing license required.

GUESTS:

- Residents may invite a reasonable number of guests but must remain with the guest(s).
- No lifeguards are on duty. Residents and guests using the lake facilities do so at their own risk.

WATERCRAFT, INCLUDING BOATS, KAYAKS AND CANOES:

- Except for lake maintenance vessels, only electric, sail, or manual power permitted.
- Paddle boards, surfboards and skim boards are prohibited.

BANK FISHING:

- Seawall parallel to the clubhouse.
- The boat launch
- Walkways to the gazebo.
- Finger pier around the gazebo.
- The dam parallel to Wolf Bay Drive.

- **WHAT'S THE BEST BAIT?** Fish are not particular. Plastic Worms, live worms, crank baits, spinner baits, popping bugs on fly rods, plastic minnows and live minnows all work for Bass, Bream, Shellcrackers and Catfish. Try pinching off bread into a ball big enough to cover the hook barb.
- **ARE FISH GOOD TO EAT?** Absolutely!
- **WHAT KIND OF FISH?** The lake was originally stocked with Bass, Bream and, Shellcrackers. 300 Grass Carp are occasionally added to control weeds.
- **HOW BIG ARE THEY?** Bream and Shellcrackers up to a pound are fairly common. In 2009, a 4-pound bass was caught beneath the Gazebo. In 2010, the lake produced an 8-pound bass and a 25-pound Carp. In 2017, a 26" bass was caught.
- **DO NOT EVER FEED THE FISH!!!** They are on a strict, healthy diet!

- IS A FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED? No.
- CAN I BRING A GUEST? Residents may invite a reasonable number of guests but must remain with them. Children 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

NO PARKING:

- On the grass anywhere.
- On either side of Lake South Drive near the boat launch property.
- On the bicycle lanes of Wolf Bay Drive or County Road 12.

FISH RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITS:

- BASS: Release bass 15 inches or larger. Bass under 15" must be kept, no limit. BREAM: (Blue Gill) and SHELLCRACKER (RedEarBlue Gill). Limit is 10 fish. CARP: Limit is 0 fish. Before releasing carp, be sure the fish is alive. CATFISH: Do not return them to the lake, regardless of the size. EEL: Do not return them to the lake, regardless of the size.
- WHERE IS THE BEST PLACE TO FISH? Areas for bank fishing are seawall parallel to clubhouse, the boat launch, walkway to gazebo, and the grassy area along Wolf Bay Drive near the dam. From a boat, at the boat launch, around the storm drains or docks. Brush was sunk around the lake as structures for bait fish to hide. No Trot lines, Jug fishing or unattended rods in the water

OTHER:

- NO FEEDING FISH. Since this practice changes the feeding habits of grass carp purchased to control grass growth in the lake, a stiff fine will be imposed on violators.
- No Trot lines or Jug fishing or untended fishing rods with lines in the water.
- No wading, except when launching or retrieving watercraft.
