

DAY 1

Fly to Morocco today

Depart from New York today and make your way to Morocco. The stunning beauty and friendly people alone are worth a visit!

Arrival and transfer to Rabat

Upon arrival at the Casablanca Mohammed V Airport, you will be met by your local guide. Make your way onward to **Rabat** to check into your local hotel.

The **5* Sofitel Rabat Jardin des Roses** is located close to the Royal Palace surrounded by 17.3 acres of Andalusian gardens with 3,000 roses. The 229 room property was designed to blend French elegance with Moroccan touches.

This afternoon the group will gather with your local guide to learn more about Morocco, get to know your fellow travelers, and have a chance to ask questions regarding the week ahead.

DAY₃

Career Enrichment

Please Note: Breakfast is included daily in your program.

Today is dedicated to professional interaction with your Moroccan counterparts including a speaker from the **Ministry of Health** (or similar) as well as a visit to a **local hospital or clinic**.

The primary objective for this journey is to explore the **healthcare challenges and opportunities** in an emerging, politically stable North African country with a long and storied cultural history. Morocco sits directly across the Strait of Gibraltar from Europe with Arab, Berber, French, Jewish, and Spanish influences on its history, economy, languages, and way of life.

Accompanying guests: After breakfast at the hotel explore Rabat including a stop to see the raising of the flag at the Royal Palace before exploring the Chellah Necropolis, the last residence of the Merinide sovereigns and former location of the old Roman city of Sale. After lunch explore the Hassan Tower, Mohammed V. Mausoleum and the Oudaya Kasbah.

Lunch will be provided this afternoon at a local restaurant.

Enjoy some time to relax this evening with dinner on your own. Perhaps enjoy the hotel's three restaurants, gorgeous pool, and gardens.

DAY 4

Depart for Fez (via Meknes)

Check out of your hotel and depart Rabat this morning as you head toward Fez. Your first stop today is in **Meknes** to visit one of the most amazing gates in the world, *Bab Mansour*. Built at the beginning of the 18th century, and completed in 1732 by his son, Sultan Moulay Ismail designed the gate as the grand entrance to the Imperial City of Meknes. Continue on to visit the Heri el Souani granary, which served both as a granary and feed store for the thousands of steeds in the sultan's vast stables. Finish your morning with a stop in a **covered market** (*medina*).

Lunch will be provided in Meknes this afternoon.

The afternoon will be dedicated to a visit to the Roman ruins in **Volubilis** (a UNESCO World heritage site). A Mauritanian capital, founded in the 3rd century B.C., this city became an important outpost of the Roman Empire and was graced with many fine buildings. Extensive remains of these survive in the archaeological site.

Drive onward to check into your local hotel in Fez late this afternoon – the **5* Sahrai Hotel**. An epitome of luxury and sophistication, don't miss their pool, spa and other first-class services. Dinner is on your own this evening.

DAY 5

Morning meeting & afternoon city tour

This morning, continue your professional exchange at a local university hospital such as **Fez University Hospital** or a similar medical facility.

Accompanying guests: After breakfast, explore Fez including the Karaouiyine Mosque, one of the most imposing in Morocco. It houses a university which is thought to be the oldest in the world and which was founded in the middle of the 9th century at a time when theology, grammar and Koranic law were the basic subjects taught. The El-Attarine medersa, situated opposite it, is considered to be the most beautiful in the medina. Also visit Fondouk el-Nejjarine – known as the "Wood Museum" – which faces the old Place el-Nejjarine or the "Carpenter's Square." The fondouk was constructed in the 18th century and originally served as a roadside inn for travellers and traders.

After lunch in the market, explore the city together including a visit to **Mellah**, the **Jewish Quarter** and **Souk el Attarine** (perfume and spice market). Some of the shops are housed in traditional Moroccan houses, so you get a bonus of seeing the old mansions up close and personal.

Dinner will be provided at a local restaurant.

DAY 6

Depart for Marrakech

Immediately after breakfast, depart for **Marrakech** via the mountains and the cedar woods of the middle Atlas, passing by Ifrane, a charming ski resort and Beni Mellal, one of the agricultural centers of Morocco. Lunch will be provided in Beni Mellal this afternoon before continuing your drive onward.

Check into your local hotel this afternoon. Enjoy some time to relax with dinner on your own this evening. The **5* Hivernage Hotel and Spa** is ideally located overlooking the Atlas mountain and the Koutoubia Mosque.

DAY 7

Day trip to the countryside

This morning the group will head into the countryside to explore a local **Berber village**. Depending on availability, visit a **local clinic or rural hospital** to learn about access to care as well as healthcare for the nomadic tribes.

Later today, the group will **visit a local school** to interact with the staff and students. Take part in a calligraphy workshop with the children and for those interested bring items (supplies) to donate to the school. **As part of your program tuition, needed furniture will be donated to the school.**

Time permitting, enjoy **tea in a Berber home** to enjoy the wonderful natural hospitality of these kind mountain people.

Enjoy lunch on your own before you head back to Marrakech for dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 8

Cultural exploration of Marrakech

Spend the day exploring Marrakech, founded by the Almoravides at the end of the 11th century. The historical sites you will visit today include the **Koutoubia Minaret**, one of the best examples of hispano-moresque art; **Bahia Palace** and gardens; and **Majorelle Gardens** built by famous French painter Jacques Majorelle.

Lunch is by individual arrangement today.

After lunch visit the famous **Jemaâ el Fna Square** and the souks. The traditional meeting place for peasants and merchants has become the heart of the city with its snake charmers, musicians and other entertainers.

Your final farewell dinner will be provided at the Jad Mahal Restaurant (or similar).
