

2019 YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION



The Model T Ford Club International Foundation, Inc. (MTFCIFI) is pleased to announce the 21st MTFCIFI Scholarship Competition. This competition is administered by the MTFCIFI, which continues to realize the importance of promoting the youth within our organization and the Model T hobby by awarding scholarships to deserving high school seniors, or equivalent for an applicant outside of the USA. This year the MTFCIFI will award up to three scholarships.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a 2019 graduating high school senior, or equivalent for an applicant outside of the USA.
- The applicant must be a member of the MTFCI or an immediate household family member must be a member of the MTFCI in good standing.
- The essay must be at least 1,000 words and all reference information used must be properly cited to be considered.
- A completed MTFCIFI Scholarship application, as published in the *Model T Times* (below), is required to accompany the applicant's essay submission.
- Applicant must submit an official transcript from his/her high school, or equivalent for outside the USA.
- Applications postmarked after May 31, 2019, will not be considered.
- The scholarship recipient must attend an accredited school or college of their choice beyond high school level.
- A check will be made out to the recipient of the scholarship and the school of their choice. Funds must be used for the 2019-2020 academic year and deposited by December 31, 2019.
- All decisions are final and there will be no private discussions regarding any candidate outside of the Board of Directors. All information remains strictly confidential.

Village Industries:

Henry Ford set up a series of smaller production facilities referred to as the "Village Industries" in an attempt to provide farm workers an income during the idle winter months. In an essay of no fewer than 1,000 words, was Henry Ford ultimately successful or not in this endeavor, and why?
