Monthly Meeting



To register: Go to Goodsearch.com - establish a user name (can be your email address) and a password. When it asks you to select a cause, type in **Carolina Cardinals Optimist Club** - When you see our name, click on it. Mark this as a favorite so that you will remember to use it every time you do a search or decide to shop online.

Now when you need to do a search, use Goodsearch instead of Google or Bing and we get a penny each time. If you shop using Goodshop, we get a percentage of the money you spend. In August, I made a purchase and we got \$2.50 from it and last month we got \$3.78 when I rented a car. Always remember to use this search engine or we won't get credit for your searches or purchases.
