January 8, 2026

Secretary's Report: Minutes from the December 2025 meeting was read by Mike Wyckoff. Motion was made and minutes were approved.

Treasurer was not present. Treasurer's Report was provided and summary was given to members.

Membership Report: 9 Board of Directors, 14 Reduced Rate Members and 273 Social Members for a total of 296 out of the 350 limit. There are 40 Life Members, 1 Honorary and 2 Junior for an additional 43 with total of 339. 13 members did not renew for the 2026 year.

County League Representative is at County League meeting.

Youth Archery will be starting on January 10, 2026. Sessions will be on the second and fourth Saturdays of the month at 6:00 PM and will go through May. Club will supply all equipment and uses the same equipment as school archery programs. Classes will be at the Indoor Range. Age limits are 6 to 16.

Youth Shooting questionnaire will be sent in summer to members to gauge interest in the program. Even though the Club supplies all equipment and ammunition, attendance has been declining the last couple of years.

Work Day major item is taking down the tracks in the Indoor Range. This will allow the ceiling drywall project to get started. When the project starts, emails will be sent to members of when the Indoor Range will not be available and the website calendar will be updated. When the drywall project is done, new LED lights will be installed for the Indoor Range and the clubhouse.
