We would like to go over a few items that will help us provide the best possible care for your child. It is important that we have everything we need to take care of your child. Here is a list of things we suggest:

- Bottles
- Bib
- Spoon
- Diapers/Diaper Cream
- Blanket/Stuffed Animal/Other Security Item
- Extra Change of Clothes-Seasonally Appropriate
- Lunch Box with Ice Pack
- Pacifier

Remember to **mark everything** with your child's name. With multiple children it becomes easy to mix things up if they aren't labeled. This includes your diaper bag, bottle, diapers, bibs, blankets, etc.

Please make sure that we have all of your emergency contacts and numbers, and that you keep them updated. It is important that we can get ahold of you in case of emergency. If you need a new form, let us know. We will put it in your child's bag.

Finally, as an important security measure, please make sure to sign your child in and out every day.
