MISSION

Supporting Youth Soccer in San Francisco and Leadership Through Sport



BRIEF SUMMARY

SFYS is a women-led comprehensive community soccer organization, benefiting San Francisco youth from ages 8-18. SFYS serves all families, regardless of race, color, religion, age, sex, or national origin within San Francisco. Roughly 8,000 families from nearly every elementary school, middle school and neighborhood in San Francisco participate with SFYS in player, league-volunteer and/or referee capacities. SFYS is the connection between the players, families and teams and facilitates low- and no-cost play through their relationship with the San Francisco Recreation & Parks Department.

What makes SFYS unique is the ability of the league to maintain and sustain socio-economic access to sport, which is dwindling across the Bay Area. SFYS must exist to keep the city of San Francisco from being solely a pay-to-play model. SFYS facilitates playing leagues, clinics and sports leadership opportunities for hundreds of independent, parent-run school-based and neighborhood teams and more than 20 soccer clubs in the City. The SF Youth Soccer playing community has the best options for all levels, as no single club has a monopoly on the sport, and SFYS facilitates low-cost opportunities to play that help eliminate barriers to entry. The organization hasn't raised Recreational fees in two decades and still operates with a lean but effective crew of 4 FTEs so it can continue to offer quality services at low- and no cost to member clubs and families.







Our Board Members are all volunteers - both in our soccer community and on our SFYS Board.




KEY STAFF
