DESCRIPTION: The Jaguar was Tri-State Archery's (United States Archery Company) flagship bow. This old gal is an amazingly accurate shooter in excellent condition for its age. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in very good shape. This bow was recently shot in the field and also put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate as shown, and a new string.

This bow sold for \$69.50 in 1961 (more than the Bear Kodiak Magnum), which translates to \$716 in 2024 inflation adjusted dollars.
