

Town of Baldwin, Maine SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, JULY 30th, 2019, 6:30 P.M.

Attendance: Selectmen: Dwight Warren, Jim Dolloff and Gerry Brown as well as members of the Public.

1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:35 PM by Dwight Warren.

2. Review/ Approve meeting minutes

Dwight Warrent requested a motion to accept and approve July 16th, 2019 meeting minutes. Jim Dolloff made a motion, Gerry Brown seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve meeting minutes.

3. Review/ Approve warrant

Dwight Warren requested a motion to accept and approve July 30th, 2019 warrant. Jim Dolloff made a motion, Gerry Brown seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve the warrant.

New Business

- Open Fuel Bids: Selectmen opened and reviewed fuel bids received from CN Brown. The bid for #2 heating oil was \$2.2631/ gallon, and for diesel was \$2.33/gallon. Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept C.N. Brown bids for number 2 heating oil and diesel.
- Sand Pond damage last Saturday: Dwight Warren went to the beach this past Saturday, the
 pillons are the beach were broken, pool noodle delineating the swimming area were torn off, signs
 were ripped down. The Sherriff department needs to be notified and has to witness it happening
 when there is a problem. Will contact the Sherriff office to get clarification on the issues and if
 they can enforce the Sand Pond ordinance and town rules.
- Trash pickup at Sand Pond: Selectmen office got quotes on trash pickup at Sand Pond. R.W. Herrick was contacted and submitted a price of \$107.53 for one pickup per week. Mellen's submitted a quote of \$100 per month, and emptying the barrels once a week or more if needed. Casella was contacted, and they do not empty barrels, only their own dumpsters. The Selectmen discussed and voted 3-0 to accept Mellen's quote.

Old Business

- Review Cumberland County Contract Addendum: Selectmen reviewed the addendum provided by Jim Gailey at Cumberland County. The addendum provided a cost for the 2nd and 3rd year of the contract, which was not given in the original contract. Selectmen reviewed and accepted the addendum. The addendum was signed.
- <u>Camera Update</u> Chris Sanborn will be boosting the existing wifi in the office so the cameras will
 hopefully work better and more dependable. Also, he is adding a guest login for people to access
 the wifi on a separate router.
- <u>Planning Board</u>
 — Selectmen reviewed and discussed Josiah Pierce re-appointment as a Planning Board Member. Selectmen voted 2-1 and re-appointed Jo for three-year term.
