# AIR FORCE ADDS MORE REPEATERS TO CALIFORNIA PAVE PAWS PROBLEM LIST

A second round of testing by US Air Force engineers has resulted in the identification of an additional seventy-five 70 cm repeaters in Northern California that must adjust their operations to eliminate harmful interference to the PAVE PAWS Updated Early Warning Radar (UEWR) located at Beale Air Force Base near Sacramento. As a result of these additions, new strategies for handling the situation are being put into place by the ARRL and the FCC.

"While ARRL knew that there was the possibility of additional repeaters being added in the follow-up list of those requiring mitigation, we are surprised by the large number of additions to the list," said ARRL Regulatory Information Manager Dan Henderson, N1ND.

On these cold and rainy days a nice hot soup sounds like just the ticket: From Bob W6WTJ and Joanne

## **Italian Sausage & Spinach Soup**

1 Package Trader Joe's Sweet Italian Sausage 2 or 3 Container's T J's Organic Chicken Broth 1/2 Medium Onion, chopped 1 Large Can Chopped Tomatoes 1 Cup Rice 6 oz Baby Spinach (or more to taste) Joanne adds garlic to this list.

Remove sausage from casing and sauté with onion over medium-high heat until cooked trough, breaking the sausage apart as it cooks. Add Chicken Broth and heat until just boiling. Add Tomatoes and Rice; reduce heat, cover and simmer until rice is cooked, about 20 minutes. (longer if using brown rice). Add spinach and cook until spinach takes on a vibrant green color. Serve immediately.

Joanne and Bob recommend trimming the tuff stems from the spinach and don't forget the garlic!
