

Enjoy a visit to Sandakan and Sukau including exploration of the Orangutan Rehab Center to learn about the plight of these incredible animals. Take a boat journey to Sukau to further explore the flora and fauna of this beautiful region.

DAY 1: NOVEMBER 17, 2019

Sandakan, Malaysia

Arrive this morning in Sandakan, where your guide will meet you at the airport for your transfer to the Sepilok Nature Resort. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax and get settled.

This evening enjoy a guided night walk to the Sepilok Forest Trails to experience walking in the dark to spot the local animals and insects. After an hour exploring, return to the resort for dinner.

DAY 2: NOVEMBER 18, 2019

Sukau, Malaysia

After breakfast at the resort, check out of the hotel and depart for your day of exploration.

At 9:00 AM, transfer to **Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Center**. Watch a short video introduction that shares information about the plight of the orangutans and the center's ongoing efforts to protect them. Walk ten minutes through the rainforest on wooden boardwalks to witness firsthand the feeding of the orangutans before heading to the new nursery area for the young. Finish up your visit with a stop at the Borneo Sun Bear Conservation Center to learn about their conservation efforts of the world's smallest bear.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner


Overnight: Sakau Rainforest Lodge (or similar)

DAY 3: NOVEMBER 19, 2019

Sukau, Malaysia

Take an early morning river cruise up the Kinabatangan River to **Kelenanap Oxbow Lake** to view more birds and wildlife.

Return to the lodge for breakfast, before proceeding for an educational tour along the lodge's **Hornbill Boardwalk** with an in-house naturalist.



After lunch, join them for an Orangutan talk and activity.

Later this afternoon, head out for another river cruise to see the local wildlife.

PACKING: Bring along sun block lotion, personal toiletries, small flashlight, insect repellent, personal refillable water bottle, walking shoes, binoculars, camera, hat & raincoat.



Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight: Sakau Rainforest Lodge (or similar)

DAY 4: NOVEMBER 20, 2019

After breakfast, return to Sandakan by boat. After lunch at a local restaurant, fly to Kuala Lumpur with an early evening arrival. Transfer to the airport hotel for check-in and overnight with dinner on your own arrangement.

Hotel: Sama Sama Airport Express Hotel

DAY 5: NOVEMBER 21, 2019

Depart late this morning or early afternoon for home (arrival in San Francisco the same day).

Note: The hotel is attached to the Kuala Lumpur International Airport so you will make your way via foot from the lobby across a sky bridge to the departure hall to check in for your flight (approximately a 10 minute walk).


