

Ordinance No. 391

An Ordinance concerning Sidewalks in the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Sec. 1. That a side walk be built <sup>and maintained</sup> ~~and maintained~~ <sup>four</sup> ~~not less than three~~ feet wide from Oak Street in said City, to the west line thereof, on the south side of Blocks 7, 8, 9, and ten in accordance with Ordinance No. 320 with in 30 days after the taking effect of this ordinance.

Sec. 2 Should any property owner in any of said blocks fail to build and maintain said walk in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, then and in that case, it shall be the duty of the street commissioner to build the same, and the City clerk shall certify the cost thereof to the County Clerk, to be placed on the tax roll against said property.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Garnett Evening Review, in said City.
