

THE KING JAMES VERSION BIBLE COMPARED TO THE JOSEPH SMITH TRANSLATION

<p>John 1:1-20 KJV</p> <p>In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.</p> <p>2 The same was in the beginning with God.</p> <p>3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.</p> <p>4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men.</p> <p>5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.</p> <p>6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.</p> <p>7 The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.</p> <p>8 He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.</p> <p>9 That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.</p> <p>10 He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.</p> <p>11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.</p> <p>12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:</p> <p>13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.</p> <p>14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.</p> <p>15 John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me.</p> <p>16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.</p>	<p>John 1:1–20 JST</p> <p>1 In the beginning was the <i>gospel preached through the Son. And the gospel was the word, and the word was with the Son, and the Son was with God, and the Son was of God.</i></p> <p>2 The same was in the beginning with God.</p> <p>3 All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made which was made.</p> <p>4 In him was <i>the gospel</i>, and <i>the gospel was the life</i>, and the life was the light of men;</p> <p>5 And the light shineth <i>in the world</i>, and the <i>world perceiveth</i> it not.</p> <p>6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.</p> <p>7 The same came <i>into the world</i> for a witness, to bear witness of the light, <i>to bear record of the gospel through the Son, unto all</i>, that through him <i>men</i> might believe.</p> <p>8 He was not that light, but <i>came</i> to bear witness of that light,</p> <p>9 <i>Which</i> was the true light, which lighteth every man <i>who</i> cometh into the world;</p> <p>10 <i>Even the Son of God.</i> He <i>who</i> was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.</p> <p>11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.</p> <p>12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God; <i>only</i> to them <i>who</i> believe on his name.</p> <p>13 <i>He</i> was born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.</p> <p>14 And the <i>same</i> word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the Only Begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.</p> <p>15 John <i>bear</i> witness of him, and cried, saying, This <i>is</i> he of whom I spake; He <i>who</i> cometh after me, is preferred before me; for he was before me.</p> <p>16 <i>For in the beginning was the Word, even the Son, who is made flesh, and sent unto us by the will of the Father, And as many as believe on his name shall receive of his fulness.</i> And of his fulness have all we received, <i>even immortality and eternal life, through his grace.</i></p>

17 For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

19 And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?

20 And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.

21 And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No.

17 For the law was given *through* Moses, but *life* and truth came *through* Jesus Christ.

18 *For the law was after a carnal commandment, to the administration of death; but the gospel was after the power of an endless life, through Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father.*

19 *And no man hath seen God at any time, except he hath borne record of the Son; for except it is through him no man can be saved.*

20 And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem, to ask him; Who art thou?

21 And he confessed, and denied not *that he was Elias*; but confessed, *saying*; I am not the Christ.
