In the event that spots for camp do not become available, we will either offer you to reserve your spot for LOM Summer Camp 2020 or refund your \$50 Down Payment.

Activities: Archery, shooting safety and shooting skills with .22's and shotguns, fresh water and shark fishing, boating with canoes and kayaks, wildlife management lessons, compassing, Bible studies built on God's creation and much more! Due to the physical nature of the activities campers need to be at least 10 years old unless accompanied by a parent.

Focus: Our first goal is to use the camp setting amid God's great creation to bring our campers and their families into a vibrant and growing relationship with God through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Second, our goal is to pass down outdoor recreation skills that many of our youth are not getting the opportunity to experience. We hope that through this experience they will develop new hobbies that will last a lifetime.

Thirdly, we want to use this setting to instill a love for God's great creation that will result in a wise understanding of our role as God's children to use, enjoy and yet conserve the gift God has given us through His creation.

What to bring:

- ___ Outdoor clothing (long pants and shorts are recommended)
- ___ Bathing Suit
- ___ Insect spray
- ___ Tennis shoes or boots – bring an extra pair
- ___ Toiletries
- ___ Towels/wash cloth
- ___ Bible and notebook
- ___ Flashlight

Things to NOT Bring:

- NO cell phones or electronic devices! If brought, they will be collected and returned at week's end.
- All fishing gear will be supplied however, you are welcome to bring your own.
- All shooting gear will be supplied however, if you choose to bring your own .22 rifle or shot gun, please make sure you have your serial number recorded at home. Make sure your gun is unloaded, cased, and the action is open.
- DO NOT BRING AMMUNITION. We will supply all ammunition as needed for safety reasons!
