

Website Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to Nissa Keyashian, M.D. Please read this privacy notice carefully as it contains important information on who we are, how and why we collect, store, use, and share personal information, your rights in relation to your personal information and on how to contact us and supervisory authorities in the event you have a complaint.

By using our website drnissak.com you signify your consent to the terms of our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with any terms of this Privacy Policy, please do not use this site or submit any personal information to us.

1. Who We Are

Nissa Keyashian, M.D. and operating at drnissak.com collects, uses and is responsible for certain personal information about you.

2. Children's Online Privacy Protection Act

This website and any products and services offered herein are not intended for persons under the age of 13. Drnissak.com does not knowingly collect information from anyone under 13 years of age. Drnissak.com prohibits children under the age of 13 from using all interactive portions of this website, including leaving any comments, filling out forms, or otherwise submitting information. Drnissak.com will not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under 13. If Drnissak.com learns it has any information or content from anyone under the age of 13, it will delete that information.

3. The Personal Information We Collect and Use

a. *Information Collected by Us*

Drnissak.com may collect, use, and is responsible for certain personal information that you provide when you voluntarily fill out any type of form or otherwise contact Drnissak.com via an online form or e-mail. The information collected may include your name, e-mail, address, phone number, and/or billing information. You are not required to provide any personally identifiable information to merely access or visit this website.

b. *Information Collected from Other Sources*

We also obtain protected health information from Zocdoc.com if you request an appointment.

c. *How we use your personal information*

Nissa Keyashian, M.D. collects such information in order to provide medical care and bill for our services.

d. *Who We Share Your Personal Information With*

Nissa Keyashian, M.D. respects your privacy and will never sell, trade or transfer your personally identifiable information to third parties (beyond what is necessary for billing) without your consent.

We do, however, share billing information with insurance companies and credit card processors.

This data sharing enables us to provide and bill for medical care. Those third-party recipients are based outside the European Economic Area or the UK— for further information including on how we safeguard your personal data when this occurs, see Transfer of your information out of the EEA, UK below.

We will not share your personal information with any other third party.

e. ***Whether Information Has to Be Provided by You and Why***

We do not require you to provide any personal data in order to view information on the website.

4. Out of the EEA, UK

This website is operated in the United States and third parties with whom we might share your personal information as explained above are also located in the United States. If you are located in the EEA, the UK, or elsewhere outside of the United States, please be aware that **any information you provide will be transferred to the United States**. By using this website, participating in any of its services and/or providing your information, you consent to this transfer.

These countries do not have the same data protection laws as the EEA or UK. While the European Commission has not given a formal decision that the United States provides an adequate level of data protection similar to those which apply in the EEA, any transfer of your personal information will be subject to the derogation in Article 49 permitting non-repetitive transfers that concern only a limited number of data subjects, as permitted by Article 49 of the General Data Protection Regulation that is designed to help safeguard your privacy rights and give you remedies in the unlikely event of a misuse of your personal information.

5. Your Rights
