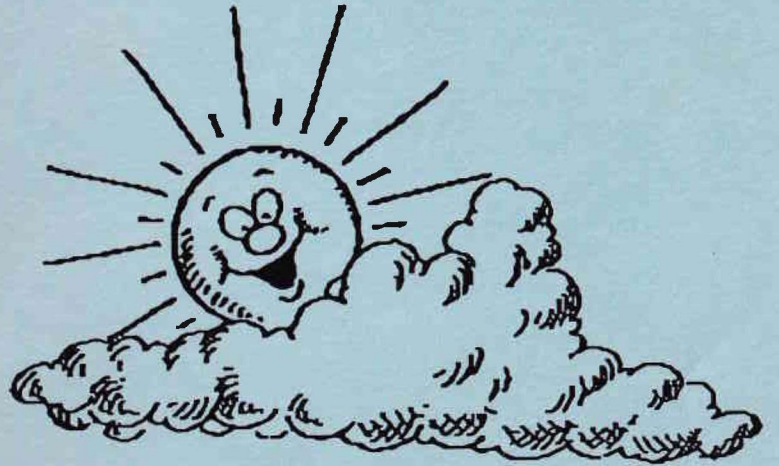

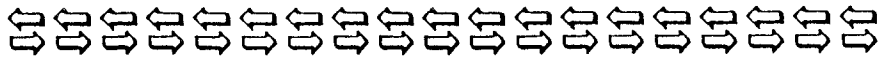

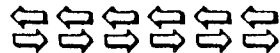


Editor's Page

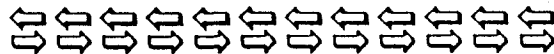
not meant to be figured out.

Games

50 and out - this is a game that goes pretty quick and is a good one to kill time, like at a tournament. In fact it is often played at tournaments by many players as a form of practice and betting.

The basic idea is that each player starts with 50 points and you try to take it out on a double. Your first dart is normally thrown at double bull, if you miss, you then try to take out what is left with your other two darts. If you hit it, everyone else playing gets a turn at taking it out. If nobody else does, you win. If someone takes it out, then it is a tie among all players and you continue with the rotation except that the pot is increased (usually \$1 per player).

This continues until someone hits it and nobody else does. an excellent practice game, since you are shooting at bulls and doubles every throw.

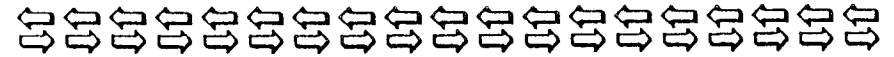
We want to say a special thank you to Tereasa Wahlrab & her mother who,

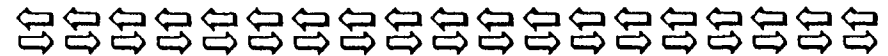
To the Editor,
