This year we have secured an agreement with the Humane Society of Broward to provide basic vet care for our clients' pets, we have built a doggie play yard for our clients and foster pets, our partnership with the Rescue Bank has grown to a new level which enables us to accept into the program additional pets and their families.

The work we do is tremendous; we are one of the largest pet retention programs in South Florida. We are unique because once a pet enters our program we provide for them for their entire life.

It is very rewarding to know that we are a part of keeping over 1500 animals out of shelters or worse.

The Pet Project for Pets is extremely pleased to announce another outstanding collaboration with the Humane Society of Broward County.

As of November 2018 the Humane Society of Broward County will be bringing their mobile veterinary unit to our Pet Project family! They will be joining us on the first Saturday of each month providing essential veterinary services.



Veterinary services that will be provided to Pet Project for Pets clients at **no cost** are:

- Vaccinations
- Heartworm Testing - Heartgard® will be provided if heartworm test is negative - if positive the client will need to be referred to a veterinarian
- Generalized deworming
- Flea and tick preventative
- Ask the vet - Providing advice or direction for any of your pet questions
- Rabies vaccination & tags - Rabies certificate will be issued at no cost but tag(s) must be purchased at these fees:

Rabies Tags

Sterilized Cats - \$15
Non-Sterilized Cats - \$25
Sterilized Dogs - \$30
Non-Sterilized Dogs - \$55



This is an amazing program which will assist our clients in the care of their pets. The emphasis is on prevention.

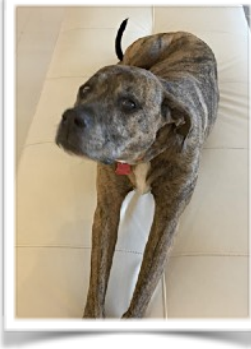

Greater Good Rescue Bank

In our third year of being the Florida affiliate for Greater Good Rescue Bank, we have received and distributed 23 truckloads, 920,000 pounds of pet food and pet supplies to over 100 South Florida 501 c3 pet rescues out of our Wilton Manors warehouse.

In 2018, we expanded that effort and began operating a warehouse in De Land providing the distribution of donated pet food and supplies to an additional 35 rescue groups in the Central Florida area. We distributed 4 Truckloads, 160,000 pounds of pet food and supplies.

These donated products reduce the food costs and enable us to help so many more pets in need and when you multiply that by 135 rescue groups, that is a huge amount of additional pets saved. This program is amazing..



Doggie Play Yard Grand Opening

On Saturday November 10 our long awaited Doggie Play Yard opened. The concept began in early 2017 and was partially funded by a grant from Our - Fund. The work began to secure the yard with a wooden fence, level out portions of the yard, asphalt and concrete portions of the yard and tree work. Well on its way by September 2017 when Irma came along and damaged much of the back yard. Fallen Trees had crashed our fence, our building's roof was damaged and our HVAC units were totaled.

The play yard project was on hold until July of 2018 when one of our very generous donors offers us a \$5,000 match gift. In no time we were able to secure the \$5,000 match and the project was completed.

The play yard is for pets and their pet parents to enjoy. There are kiddie swimming pools, agility tunnels, toys, Frisbees, all in a fun and safe place for all to enjoy.



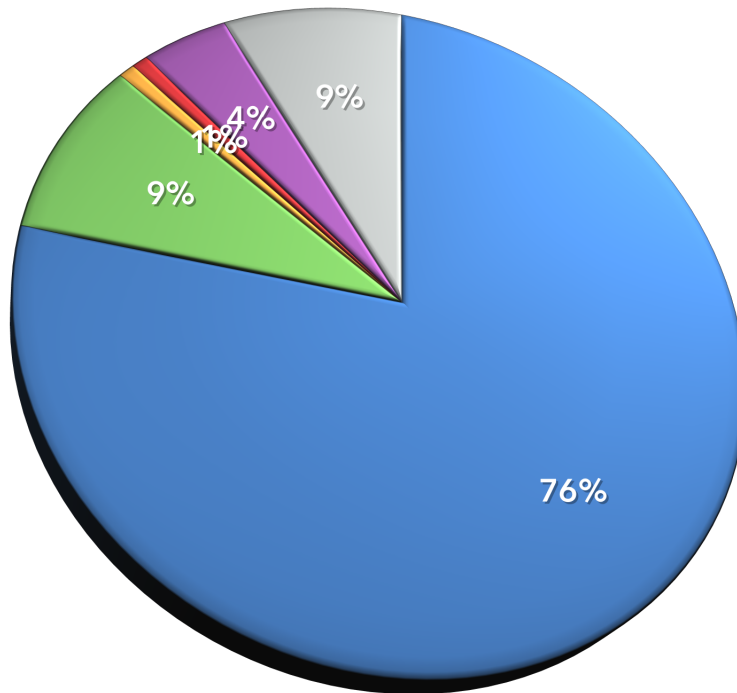
