of the Lord all my whole life long.



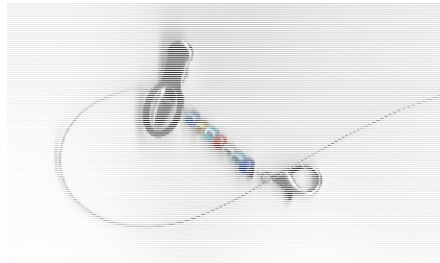
23rd Psalm Bead How To:

1. Choose bag and sign your name on it.
2. Choose a stringer wire.

Thread a latch and crimper bead,
loop around leaving a short extension
crimp the bead to hold in place



3. Thread spacer beads and sheep on wire
(make sure to cover the short tail of the wire with beads)



4. Use clip (or tape) to keep beads from coming off wire.
5. Put beads in bag and fold top down.
6. Continue in same manner each day, using appropriate bead each day with spacer beads between (see photo of finished beads).
 1. Sheep
 2. Green
 3. Blue
 4. Rock
 5. Lava
 6. Wood
 7. Clear
 8. Heart
 9. Cross - Add crimper bead before cross, and loop end back up through beads, crimp to hold in place.
