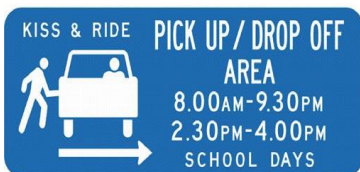


KISS AND RIDE

Understanding the rules

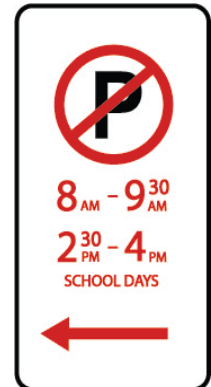
Kiss and Ride zones and rules are for your child's safety, your convenience and to minimize congestion and confusion.



Kiss and Ride rules:

- Kiss and Ride zones and 'No Parking' zones operate under the same conditions – may stop to drop off or pick up your children in this area
- Driver must remain in their vehicle
- Zone applies only during hours of operation.

Possible minimum penalty of \$35



Remember...

• Do not exit your vehicle

To assist with traffic flow, drivers must remain in the car while children get in and out. Children should travel with bags in the car (not in the trunk).

• Be timely

Arrive with time to spare to avoid busiest times. If your child does not appear as you approach the *Kiss & Ride* area for pick up, you must take a lap around Roland Crescent and re-enter the line-up. You may not wait in the Kiss & Ride zone.

• Stay in sequence

Don't cut in the queue. Drop off/ pick up your child at the top of the zone, (at the light standard) allowing vehicles following you to enter the zone in an orderly manner. Do not attempt to enter the Kiss & Ride area unless there is space for your vehicle.

• No U-turns or use of private drives to turn around on Stoneybrook Crescent

Do not do u-turns in busy school zones. They are dangerous and put children at risk.

• Child safety

Children should enter/exit vehicle on the curb side only. Ensure children have their restraints securely fastened until you come to a complete stop and before driving off.

• Do not double park

It is both illegal and dangerous to have children walking between stopped vehicles.

• Do not block Bus Zone

From light standard to parking lot entrance as marked by signs.

Kiss & Ride requires cooperation to ensure the safety of all children.
