Albert Verbrugge, 84, of Sebewaing died Monday evening, Feb. 18, 2002, at his home following a one-year illness. He was born Aug. 12, 1917, in Superior, Wisc., son of the late Constant and Zulma (Steen) Verbrugge. He was united in marriage to Velma Sveller in Los Angeles, Calif., in 1942. She preceded him in death on Jan. 26, 1996. Al was a commercial-residential painter in the Detroit area for many years before retiring and moving to Sebewaing in 1988.
