

Bowron, Harold

Harold J. Bowron, 85, of Bad Axe died Monday, September 9, 2002, at Huron Medical Center in Bad Axe. He was born on Oct. 2, 1916, in Ubyly to the late Allen and Ethel (Snodden) Bowron. Harold and Dorothy Schram were united in marriage on Nov. 26, 1955. Harold was raised on a farm and attended Ubyly schools. He owned Allen Bowron and Sons, an Allis Chalmers dealer, from 1945 to 1959. He also worked for Thumb Oil and Gas for seven years and for Osentoski Farm Equipment Co. until his retirement in 1978.
