As people continue to read these words that You have placed on my heart I know that Your Holy Spirit is reaching deep inside of them, peeling back the layers of brokenness and showing them in only a way that You can and that it doesn't matter who we were, where we have come from or what we have done YOU LOVE EACH AND EVERY ONE OF US! I pray that anything written on these pages that are NOT of You be washed away in the precious Blood of Your Son, Jesus. I ask these things with complete confidence and expectation, in Jesus' name. AMEN!"

With all those new feelings that were going on inside of me I began searching for a church that might allow some long haired, bearded, ole scooter guy in the back door to listen for a minute. Not every time but a few times I could feel the eyes of certain ones in congregations staring at me. Sometimes this caused me to feel uncomfortable but the greater desire inside of me to know Jesus always caused me to stay for the whole service. Because of that I feel it's important that I mention again that the uncomfortableness could have been only my perception of their reactions. Who knows? Instead, when I walked in they quite possibly could have been praising Jesus. Why? Maybe they had been praying for one of their lost loved ones and when they seen the likes of me they were not in judgment but in a state of thankfulness that there is always hope!

There was one particular person, from the past, still in my life that had already taken the leap from the chaos to Jesus. And truthfully, prior to the accident, it was seeing something so different in her that was now drawing me to want this same Jesus in my life. So with Michelle and her together we began our quest to find a church. Then one day I heard an advertisement on a Christian radio station that Brian "HEAD" Welch, former lead guitarist of the rock band 'Korn' was coming to one of the churches that we had already been to. The radio said he was coming to share his testimony of how Jesus came into his life. WHAT?!! I was never into that kind of music but I did remember 'KORN" and having listened to some of the lyrics of their songs, I was more than curious to hear what God had done that affected a cat like that. I KNOW, I KNOW! Sounds a bit arrogant huh? Like his sins were any worse than mine. Anyways, a small group of us decided we weren't going to miss hearing his testimony. We showed up early and had seats in about the 5th or 6th row from the front. OH MY GOSH! The place was packed. Hundreds and hundreds of people! There were people of all ages with an overflowing amount of young people, even the balcony's were full! After God had the entire place in tears of joy Brian wanted to pray over and for people. I ran! I was probably the 10th person to the altar. I honestly don't know how long we were down there at the altar. But, as I turned to head back to my seat it was then that I saw the flow of people now in front of me. It was guite obvious how God had used Brian's testimony and affected nearly every single person there. You want to talk about an altar call to As I said, when I turned around I seen that nearly every seat in the church was empty now. Why? Because EVERYONE was either at the altar or in the isles trying to reach the altar!! PRAISE GOD!

I'd like to share a couple paragraphs from the introduction of Brian 'HEAD' Welch's book titled SAVE ME FROM MYSELF. As you read this see if any of it sounds familiar.

"Like most people, I've had enough ups and downs to drive a man crazy. Like most people, my heart has been beaten up pretty badly throughout the years by myself and by others. Like most people, many of the things that I've chased after in my life have left me feeling empty and unsatisfied ... **Unlike** most people, I gave all this up - my music, my band, my career, everything - when I had an encounter with God. After that, all I wanted to do was focus on my future, sweeping everything from my past under the rug and moving on with my new life. Or, at least, that was my plan ... Well, I prayed about it, and after a lot of thought, I came to the conclusion that exposing all the darkness from my past would be part of my healing process. I also came to see that discussing some of the stupid things I've done might save a lot of people from going down the same roads of destruction that I traveled on." (Brian "HEAD" Welch)

God placed this very same desire in me when He nudged me to write my testimony, to share some of the darkness from my past with others in hopes that you or someone you know can also avoid the chaos that I came to know all too well. It's important to understand that I'm not trying to glamorize any of my drug using, gun packing, you fill in the blanks past ... honestly, I'm simply attempting to be obedient to God. I really feel like God wanted me to tell my story and how this new life has unfolded to be what it is today, since I've given Him the 'handlebars' of my life. God has begun taking the very things 'I' was putting myself through and is turning it around, and eventually He will use it ALL to bring Him glory! AMEN?! **That's not just what He does, but that's His character, Who He truly IS**! My life has never been happier. And if He did it for me, and He did, He WILL do it for anybody.

After the service was over we were moving through the hallway on our way out when all of a sudden we ran into several other people that I believed had simply disappeared a few years earlier. With mouths wide open in amazement and pointing at each other like, "You're in a church?" I just had to know so I asked, "Is this where you've been all this time?"

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With big grins on their faces they simply responded, "Yep! This is where all the cool cats hang out now! Jesus is real and God is Good!" That day we all decided to make it a point to keep in touch. "Maybe we could stay in contact with each other and see what God is doing in each other's lives," we said. And that is exactly what we did. Those couple little rendezvous began to fan some sparks until ... someone spoke up and said, "Hey, I remember a couple of years ago feeling this very same thing we're talking about!" I was shocked and amazed when I heard this. In a quickness I responded, "Then what have you been waiting for? That's what we're going to do!" And that my brothers and sisters turned out to be, and is what we still 8 years later refer to as the "*Glary Meetings* of the Overcomers for Christ"!

We first began meeting in someone's kitchen, at 2 p.m. every Sunday afternoon. There were 8 of us at the first meeting. In just a couple of weeks our numbers grew until we had to take the meeting to a larger kitchen, then a living room, then, eventually, we were in a backyard with 43 people setting in a huge circle, having church. People were asking around and coming to see if it were true, "Are ALL those people really clean, sober, happy and sitting around talking about Jesus?" We quickly grew out of that backyard and had to find a place to take the meetings. Someone that was coming to the meetings pretty regular asked the church he was going to if they might be able to help us with this situation. Praise God! They blessed us with two adjacent rooms and all the chairs we needed. It was crazy though, most of the people that were coming didn't really want to go into 'the' church building. It was obvious that 'church' is not a building but, a gathering of the people. In fact Jesus tells us, in *Matthew 18:19-20* in the Message Bible that, "When two of you get tagether an anything at all on earth and make a prayer of It, My Father In heaven grees into action. And when two or three of you are tagether because of like, you can be sure that I'll be there." NO PROBLEM! So, just like in the backyard, we took all of the chairs out of the rooms we were blessed with and sat them in a circle outside on the concrete and the people kept coming!

The numbers started to dwindle down but there were still two of us that shared the vision. It was at that point that we felt in our spirits, "Send hope, Love and encouragement." I was a little confused at first because the only people I knew were prostitutes, murderers, thieves and convicts. While in the middle of that thought I felt, "Exactly! These are the ones that have lost sight of all three of these things!" Almost immediately it seemed like I was always writing something down from either a church service I'd been to or from what I was reading in the Bible. Within a few days these 'things' were typed and edited. Then we printed and sent the very first Oxymetry for Clariet newsletter in September of 2007. It was a single 8 1/2 x 11 piece of paper. On the front was a group picture from one of our first meetings with a caption below it that read, "LOOK CLOSELY, DO YOU RECOGNIZE ANY OF THESE PEOPLE?" On the back side was the poem I'd written called A Promise Is a Promise and a big red "UNDO" button. We prayed over them and then put them in the mail to some friends that were incarcerated. God knew we knew way more incarcerated people than the 35 people that received the first copy. As you look at the copy you have in your hands today you can see the growth. The newsletter has grown due to the fact that all of you now see the vision and have come on board to FILL the mailbox with volumes of material that the Holy Spirit has also inspired each of you to write. **Together** we have grown, and will continue to grow, to reach an even greater level of wisdom and knowledge along with a deeper understanding of God's Word. None of us are to our destination yet, BUT for sure we're Not where we used to be! AMEN?!

I pray that all of you can see, at this point, that this has already changed from my testimony to 'OUR' testimonies. Like any church it's not just the pastor that builds a church. In fact it's the congregation's responsibility to bring in the sheep and that's exactly what all of you have done over these eight years. The pastor is there to feed the sheep that come in to God's house. ALL of you have responded to the Holy Spirit, whether you were first aware of it or not. How do I know this? Because the devil would NEVER lay it on your hearts to write to us because he knows the things we're going to tell you about. And the last thing he wants you to hear is that Jesus loves you, that He died for your sins and that He wants to give you a better life by simply choosing Him to be your Lord and Savior! Of course with God's guidance it has taken ALL of us together, listening to the Holy Spirit, to get this ministry where it is today. Many of you believe that there is some huge team of people out here that have been doing what you've been reading. That's not the truth.

In the first two or three years there was a larger group consistently coming and helping, as I'm sure you've seen in the pictures. We so APPRE IATE ALL the helping hands and hearts that God has brought to us. However, in the last 4 1/2 years it has been Michelle, our daughter Courtney, our son-in-law John, our grandsons now and then, Julie and myself on the outside. AND EVERY ONE OF YOU ON THE INSIDE that has helped keep this vision (church) alive! In this past year God has begun to bring more people to help in many various ways! Praise God! What's my point here? The point is that it doesn't take a huge group to reach multitudes of people. In fact, in the beginning of Jesus' ministry He used 12 men and various women to help change the whole world. What it does take though is for people to surrender and respond to His call. Our first heart's desire should be to serve our King, Jesus. I truly believe that this new expansion is due to the even greater things that He has planned for us all.

Okay, now I'm going to ask you to slightly shift yourselves in your chairs and hopefully stay with me as we continue on, about vision. Let's start in 1 Samuel 3:1 (AMP) where we read that, "... The word of the Lord was rare and precious in

So I had to take a trip to the hospital the other morning. It seems as I've had a mini stroke but I know that God has His hands all over me. It's going to be a long road over these next 4 years and my prayer request is that you all will remain with me through it. I have gone through a lot of loss and pain but I do my best to remain faithful in my walk with Jesus. Even though I have been through a lot and have seen a lot I know I will walk away from anyone who is trying to do wrong to others. I've went to many places where most men I know would NEVER go. Today, for myself anyways, I know that Jesus Christ is with me ALWAYS! The only other person I knew out there or wrote to was my best friend since we were 5 - 6 years old and she passed away 5 1/2 years ago. So, I've made you all my new family! I know that our Father has a much better plan for me, that's the good news. Let's ALL keep the homeless out there in our prayers, please ...G.B.B.

Look, I have a few children that I thought I would never see. One by my first wife and a second one by my last wife. So two weeks ago my daughter, Kari, by my first wife found me and wrote to me. And guess what? She has two children and so that means that I have a new granddaughter and a new grandson! Then shortly after that connection I heard from my son Jeffrey. It seems as though he has gotten himself locked up as well. The last time that I seen him he was 3 years old and I was holding him in my arms. Today he is 22 years old. I am so thankful that they both have found me AND they want to be in my life! Boy let me tell you, I have never cried so much. I truly thank God so much ... **G.B.B.**

I am better than ever in spite of the fact that I am in prison. I have received the biggest blessing on the 21st of April. Do you recall that I wrote to you and asked for you to pray for my boys' well-being, because I hadn't heard from them in months? Well, God is great and He is always with us! I have received a letter from my ex-husband and my youngest son! My son is 15 years old and he tells me that he attends Christian services. Also, my ex tells me that he promised our son that he would stop using drugs. He has been clean for one month. My ex-husband told me he has to start changing his way of life and that his goal is to be baptized! Hallelujah!! I am so happy and I cried so much that day that my eyes were swollen for two days ... **M.V.**

Great news! God did divinely heal the high blood pressure I had for years! I don't have it anymore. I have been off the three meds that I used to take to keep my blood pressure normal. It's been seven months now and not once has my pressure been abnormal. In fact, I have had better than textbook normal readings. I thank God for that ... J.C.

God is so amazing! When I was feeling down and having trouble dealing with my emotions, God came through. At first, I didn't know who to confide in. So, I prayed to God to help me with these emotions. Basically, this is what happened, I got back from work and there was a girl that got here, she looked familiar so I asked my neighbor if she asked her name. She did and it was who I thought it was. Her son

was the one that is being charged for the murder of the father of my child. Now, I don't know if I'm supposed to say this, but it's part of my testimony. So, I was crying practically all day as I relived all the hurt and pain. I wanted to ask her questions, but I didn't have the courage. So, I fell asleep and when I woke up, I had the newsletter. In 2 Samuel 7:18, King David begins his prayer to the LORD humbly, but with acceptance by saying, "Who am I, Sovereign LORD, and what is my family, that You have brought me this far?" Then in 2 Samuel 7:19, David begins to bring to the LORD's remembrance a few of the things He has promised him and his lineage, "And if this were not enough in Your sight, Sovereign LORD, You have also spoken about the future of the house of Your servant - and this decree, Sovereign LORD, is for a mere human!" David wasn't begging God to do anything. NO! Knowing that the LORD is always faithful to His Word, David was reminding Him of the promises He had made to him.

Not to flesh out and sound arrogant but it's just that I'm older, been doing time longer and been in the Word longer. I won't leave out the fact that I've also failed a lot.

I'm reaching out now because I need a big brother, out there, that I might also be accountable to. As you get to know me I'm sure that you'll find at times I'm a very excitable guy! This accountability, brother to brother, sometimes requires a mentor that can and will put his foot on your neck (spiritually) and cause you to see things in the right light. Someone who can step on your toes and not mess up your shine! And in my reaching out ... PRAISE GOD you responded!

I was saved in a Victory Outreach in January of 1992 and became a disciple in The Door Christian Fellowship Church in Tempe. I've failed and fallen out of fellowship more than once. I understand today that it was never God's will for me to fall away, ever, not even for a brief moment! However, I look back at Moses when he killed the Egyptian, and went into the wilderness for forty years and ask myself the question, "Was he backslid?" Only God knows. Still, in his failure, as in my own, God uses said failure to help bring us to an end of self AND self reliance, showing us that we need our Savior while teaching us to become completely dependent on Him. So, it has taken me many years to learn some things that other men learned much quicker. I believe that walking in the Spirit is a life - long journey of lessons.

I'm a Spaniard, raised among the Mexican American people in Southern California. So I guess you could say that I was raised among that 'tribe'. I speak Spanish better that most men speak English. So, in here I serve as a translator in some of our services. I also do a song service on Sunday mornings. I was taught to rise up in the Spirit and to serve God in serving the church AND others. I'm a firm believer in standing in the gap, not just in prayer but also in rising to meet the need of the hour. I know for certain that I am closer to God now than I've ever been in all my life. It's not because I take part in religious activities, but more so because prayer has become a way of life to me. I understand clearly that those things we do for God do NOT necessarily make us closer to Him, but rather are a byproduct or fruits of our relationship with God.



I spend a lot of time working with men in evangelism meaning I witness, share the Gospel and Scripture with those that God puts in my path. Evangelism is something that seems to just spill out of my spirit and onto those around me. Jesus said, "And I, when I am lifed up from the earth, WILL draw ALL people to Myself." (John 12:32) I have learned, over the years, that it is appropriate to 'preach' (The Cross) to the lost, and to 'teach' the church lest an un regenerated spirit grow familiar with holy things and they become as if they were common things. The natural man cannot receive spiritual things until one becomes born again (John 3:3-8), then, that new man can receive Holy Ghost revelation.

I do not fancy myself a preacher or a teacher, but some man has to rise up among us who will stand in the defense of the faith to break off right and Biblical doctrine. Why? So those new converts among us won't be burdened with the yoke of legalism, and every doctrinal wind of change that comes down the pike. So this is where I'm going with this; 'If' we are men and women of God we know that the Scriptures tell us, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed AND who correctly handles the Word of truth." And we should be ready in or out of season to share them when it is edifying. Really, I'm NOT a real religious type of cat, I'm just a simple man who loves God. And, I want to live according to His Word to the best of my understanding.

Foot's Bible Study Rotes

1 Kings 7:1-8:66

Solomon sought out Huram an expert craftsman who casted in bronze all sorts of items (furnishings) for the temple to enhance worship. Huram's items of bronze would look strange in today's churches, but we use other articles to enhance worship. Stained glass windows, crosses, pulpits hymn books, and communion tables serve as aids to worship. While the instruments of worship may change, the purpose of worship should never change - to give honor and praise to God. (7:14-47)

In his prayer of dedication, Solomon declared that even the highest heavens cannot contain God. Isn't it amazing that though the heavens can't contain God, He is willing to live in the hearts of those who love Him? The God of the universe takes up residence in His people. (8:27)

Acts 7:30-8:13

Stephen had been accused of speaking against the temple. (6:13) Although he recognized the importance of the temple, he knew that it was not more important than God. God is not limited. He lives not only in a house of worship but also in hearts of faith that are open to receive Him. (Isaiah 66:1-2) Solomon knew this when he prayed at the dedication of the temple. (2 Chronicles 6:18) God wants to live in us, is He living in you? (7:44-50)

The Jewish leaders who had condemned Jesus to death for blasphemy would not tolerate Stephen's words, so they dragged him out and killed him. People may not kill us for witnessing about Christ, but they may let us know they don't want to hear the truth and try to silence us. Keep honoring God in your conduct and words, though many may turn against you and your message, some will follow Christ, remember, Stephen's death had a profound impact on Paul, who later became the world's greatest missionary. Even those who oppose you now may later turn to Christ. (7:55-58)

Paul is a powerful example of a person who was thought impossible for God to reach and change. (7:58)

Psalm 128:1-129:8

The psalmist wrote that good family life is a reward for following God. The values outlined in God's Word include love, service, honesty, integrity, and prayer. These help all relationships, and they are especially vital to home life. Is your home life heavenly or hectic? Reading and obeying God's Word is a good place to start to make your family all that it should be. (128:1)

The people of Israel were persecuted from their earliest days but never destroyed completely. The same is true of the church. Christians have faced times of severe persecution but the church has never been destroyed. As Jesus said to Peter, "Now I say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not complete It." (Matthew 16:18) When you face persecution and discrimination, take courage - the church will never be destroyed. (129:2)

Proverbs 16:31-17:1

Self-control is superior to conquest. Success in business, school, or home life can be ruined by a person who loses control of his or her temper. So it is a great personal victory to control your temper. When you feel yourself ready to explode, remember that losing control may cause you to forfeit what you want the most. (16:32) The greatest of feasts where no expense is spared is really nothing, if there is no peace within those in attendance. It doesn't take money to gain peace, in fact, no amount of money can buy you peace. Peace comes from God Himself and it's free.

Which of course, gets me to thinking and what keeps coming up is the mustard seed and faith. *Matthew* **17:20** tells us that if you have faith even as small as a mustard seed you could move a mountain. 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those days: there was no frequent or widely spread vision." Why? By this time the prophets were rarely speaking God's messages to Israel because this was during the rule of the judges. Look now at what Proverbs 29:18 (KJV) tells us, "Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he." The NIV version of Proverbs 29:18 reads like this, "Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint, but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction." One more time. This time from the NLT translation of Proverbs 29:18, "When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful." So what is the revelation or the vision or wisdom's instruction here? It seems to me that it is both listening to and obeying the divine guidance of God. Keep coming. Now let's look to where the prophets ARE speaking the things God is giving them but the people still aren't listening. Listen to what God told Amos to tell the people this time, in Amos 8:11 (NIV), "The days are coming when I will send a famine through the land - not a famine of food or a thirst for water, but a famine of hearing the words of the Lord."

Okay now, here it is ... Although this is still going on in the world today, where people refuse to listen and follow God's guidance, we no longer have to wait to hear God speak through a prophet. Today we have the Bible to read and follow for our everyday lives. In 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT) we will read, "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip His people to do every good work." Jesus is speaking these next words, in John 14:24c-26 (NLT), to His disciples before He went to the Cross, I'm sure to encourage them, "What I am talling you is from the Pather who sant kie, I am talling you these things while I am still with you. But when the Pather sends the Advocate as My representative - that is, the Holy Spirit - He will teach you and remind you of everything [here told you." Today we are Jesus' disciples and 'if' we have received Jesus as our Lord and Savior this promise of the Holy Spirit's guidance is still for us today. In Matthew 28:18-20, Jesus has now conquered the grave, risen and came to His disciples again (that's now us too) to say, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations (people), beptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Those three verses are referred to as 'The Great Commission' or the vision for His church, which is now us as well. John records this same event as Jesus is challenging Peter three times by saying, "If you love Ma ... Then feed my lambs. Peter do you love Ma ... Then take care of My sharp." By the third time Jesus asked Peter whether he loved Him or not, Peter was hurt but answered Jesus by saying, "Lord, You know everything. You know that I love You." And one last time Jesus told Peter, "Them feed My shapp (John 21:15-17) By the way, I believe there is a reason why Jesus said these things to Peter 'three times' but that's a whole other teaching that we won't cover this time.

Even though 'we' were first given the vision for this newsletter it's NOW equally important that we share it with all of you clear enough that YOU can run with it and help build it to reach many more for the Kingdom of God! And with the help of the Holy Spirit I believe you all are seeing the vision more clearly all the time. In Matthew 7:15 Jesus' teaching is, "Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwerdly they are farcelous welves." And immediately in the next verse He says, "By their truth you will recognize them." (Matthew 7:16) Then down a couple more verses, in Matthew 7:17, 20 Jesus say's something I want us all to hone in on, "Librardian, eveny good tree beens good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them." So what am I saying? I'm just showing you what Jesus said. Looking here at Scripture it would seem that Jesus might recognize the Opproversion of Spriet as a good tree because it's a tree that has produced good lasting fruit. A tree that began with first 8 people and God grew it to be 35 people. And from those 35 people God has now grown it to be over 950 people, in over 80 different facilities across 40 plus of the United States. That's Federal, State and various county facilities. And all of you are that fruit! Don't think for a second, after those last sentences, that ANY of us has a place to get all high and mighty! NO! Why? Because Jesus tells us point blank, "You did NOT choose Ma, but I chose you," Why? "so that you might go and bear (truft trait that will last " and then He promises us as we bear good lasting fruit ".... that whatavar you aak in My name the Father WILL give you. This is My command: Love each other." (John 15:16-17) Do you want to know what we have asked The Father? We have asked that, "He continue to use this newsletter ministry to help reach others that have been deceived and caught up in the enemies lies. Help us to share Your love, and with this love we might grow an even greater Overwards for Shrist family 'tree' of fruit. Use us ALL, to first and foremost, increase Your Kingdom God." As you all can now see Jesus has been faithful to this ministry with His promise, "... that when we are bearing lasting fruit we can

ask whatever (according to His Word), in His name, and God will give it to us."

The Secretary for Shrist has NEVER been about how many people we can add to the mailing list. According to Scripture and witnessing the length Jesus went to save 'this' lost sheep, me, we've made it our purpose to follow His lead in always reaching for that 'are lost alway? Even though Jesus is teaching, in the above paragraph, about false prophet's that does not mean in no way that we are to think that we can be judgmental of others. I'm not saying that we shouldn't be conscious and alert with whom we join arms because Jesus did say to beware of 'sheep in wolves clothing', but not judgmental. Isn't it crazy how we sometimes turn Jesus' message about 'Good fruit, Bad fruit' into one of where we are more conscious of someone else's fruit or sins before we ever take a look at our own? What does it say about our own walk when we are always inspecting other people's fruit? Hey, that's just a question not an accusation? Could it be that perhaps this is why Jesus taught about judgment before He taught about fruit in Matthew 7? Let's just look to see exactly what Jesus has to say about all this in Matthew 7:1-2 (NLT). "STOP judging others, and you will not be judged. For others will treat you as you treat them. Whetever measure you use in judging others, it will be used to measure how you are judged. " I believe what Jesus is saying in that last sentence is this, you may be judging others to meet your own standard of measure. But be careful, it's not 'others' that will be doing the final judging. You will one day stand before My Father and He will judge you the vary way you judged others. OUCH! I love how the Message Bible translation 'clearly' seems to give us a Christian slap of love right on the cheek as it breaks down Matthew 7:3-5. Listen. "It's easy to see the smurdge on your adiplybor's face and be oblivious to the univ snear on your own. Do you have the narve to say, "Let me wash your face for you," when your own face is distorted by contempt? It's this whole traveling read-show mentality all over again, playing a holiar-than-thou part instand of just living YOUR part. Wipe that uply snear off your own faca, and you might be fit to offer a wesheloth to your neighbor." We ALL have done this! And, I want to add, we'll probably do it again. But, when we take that slap on the face and heed the Holy Spirit's guidance by turning our judgment into real brotherly and sisterly love THAT'S when God will begin to judge 'us' with a different measuring stick.

So in closing I want to ask you this, "What do you believe the ULTIMATE message is in all of this?" I believe it is this. Simply love others, not according to the way they love or treat you, but by the way that **JESUS** loves you!

I've been incarcerated for 12 years, since I was 18 years old and I'm 29 now. I have been on a long journey in this system, searching for that brighter horizon, and despite all the ranks I've earned, it was only within the year of 2014 in which I found what I was looking for.

I mean, it was right there in front of my eyes the whole time, I was just too blind to see it. Yet today, I'm proud to say that I've dropped out of the prison politics, AND have given my life to the Almighty Jesus Christ! The peace that I have found is so amazing. I didn't think it was possible to feel the way I do today. I wake up with a smile. I engage in peace filled conversations with others. It's AWESOME! I want to believe that I'm a Christian but I'm not sure about the whole religion thing, yet I do know that I do believe in God and what the Bible tells me.

For many years I've been lost in my ways, with the world at large absent in my life. Due to my political past and being of high risk status, I just received recreation and showers this early A.M. Everything I do is of limited movement and with a small group of individuals of the same security level, yet it's a program I've come to enjoy. I get to gather my thoughts, and work towards changing my uncivilized ways.

I found God, have received forgiveness and now feel like I can breathe again. As harsh as my reality may be I have NO worries. It's a new feeling for me and I can't help myself from smiling and sharing my new found joy. Most still can't believe that I gave up my 'patch' and gave my life to the One of a Higher Power, Jesus. They say that I must have went crazy! My answer to them is, "I did go crazy, crazy for peace and happiness!"
