Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve today's agenda and approve the minutes from the January 31st meeting with Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

A patron from Grand River Township and Mark Robinson Board Member Grand River Township met with the Commission concerning Sanders Addition, Cameron, MO. It is noted that due to tax payer funds being spent on that road in that addition that it is a county road. The patron is upset due to the blading of the road & rock being thrown into her yard. The easement on roads in the county is a 30' right of way. That particular area shows to have a 50' right of way. The County is in hopes that the Township will work with the patrons in this area. County Clerk, Melissa Meek will get in touch with the Attorney and see what easement is correct. She will also ask about the legality of an intergovernmental agreement that will allow each township to help another township should the need arise.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White advised he had attended a Region D meeting as well as a Tri-County Health meeting this past week.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee met with the Commission to get their approval for tax write-offs for years 2018 and older. Even though these taxes are written off if the patron comes in they still have the ability to collect those taxes.

Garry McFee of Howe and Company met with the Commission to see if they had any needs from his company. Also note that if the County wishes to get match dollars on federal projects a diary must be kept by our road & bridge supervisor.

The NW District Commissioner's meeting was discussed and whom to contact for donations and speakers.
