## Program: Hawaii DOT Road User Charge (HiRUC) Demonstration Project

HE UNIT ROAD USAGE CHARGE DEMONSTRATION Scot Urada will provide an update on the three-year project to investigate the use of a per-mile fee to fund upkeep of roads and bridges instead of the current system where drivers pay at the pump. With a RUC system, vehicle owners pay for actual miles driven instead of paying a state tax on the fuel they purchase. Hawaii is one of a dozen states, including California, Utah and Oregon, researching whether the switch to a pay-per-mile-driven charge is feasible and how it might be implemented. Many important factors such as sustainability, fairness, information and privacy protection are under consideration.
