Ms. Napolitani recapped the correspondence listed below:

EXECUTIVE SESSION

An executive session was not necessary.

CFO'S REPORT

Mr. Francisco was filling in for Mr. Olshefski.

The field work for the FY2017 Audit has been completed and the report is almost done. The auditor is waiting for the actuary number from the State for the Authority's share of the pension liability. Mr. Francisco expects to have another clean audit, with no negative findings, and hopes to have the audit affidavit on the agenda for next month.

The DEP has agreed to close out the loan for the Oxford WWTF Upgrade, and everyone is working on finalizing the ending balances.

Regarding the monthly financial report, there is nothing out of the ordinary. Our Cash Balance is a healthy \$6.3 million dollars. Revenues are on target for this time of year, and expenditures are slightly under budget.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Mr. Tipton updated everyone on the litigation with Tomar. The Case Management Conference was held, and all parties were present. Since everything is in the early stages, another conference was scheduled for some time in June.

Mr. Kiszonak asked Mr. Tipton what matters would require an executive session. Mr. Tipton explained that litigation (or prelitigation), personnel and contract negotiations are the three categories appropriate for an executive session. Mr. Tipton explained that if a specific employee was going to be discussed (good or bad), a Rice Notice must be sent to the employee at least 48 hours in advance of the meeting, preferably a week. The employee has the right for discussion to be held in open or closed session.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Donati distributed his report prior to the meeting.

Washington Twp. Development: Yesterday, Mr. Donati received a phone call from their engineer. It appears the development is moving forward, and they are in the approval process. The engineer is preparing the TWA application.

Oxford WWTP NJPDES Permit Renewal: The Final Permit was effective April 1, 2018. CP Engineers has been working with the Operations staff and the lab, to make sure they are aware of permit changes.

PCFA Leachate: They submitted their SIU Permit Modification request on March 8, 2018.

Rt. 31 Bridge over Furnace Brook: Previously, the Authority signed an agreement with the New Jersey Department of Transportation regarding their project. In the meantime, NJDOT is getting federal funds for the project, so, NJDOT had to modify the agreement to meet federal requirements. They sent an amended agreement for the Authority's endorsement. Although the project will probably have very little, if any effect on the Authority, Mr. Donati recommended Mr. Tipton review the documents before endorsement. Formal action by the Board was tabled until our next meeting.

Climbing Screen: There will be a meeting on Thursday with the Operations staff to review the matter.

Mr. Rosenberg asked Mr. Donati to look at a manhole on Pequest Road in Oxford when he is in the area.

There was a brief discussion about the trial test being conducted on metal with raw leachate at the Oxford facility.

AUTHORITY CONSULTANT

Mr. Wauhop's report was distributed just prior to the meeting. Chairman Chamberlain said it included the typical maintenance punch list items and the other items were already discussed. He instructed the Board to review the items on their own and save any questions for the next meeting.

FINANCE (Treasurer)

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #18-18 (Certificate No. 381: \$63,525.48) be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Fund, as presented. Mr. Rosenberg seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #18-19 (Certificate No. 389: \$25,719.20) be approved to pay all bills from the Capital Improvements Fund as presented. Ms. O'Connor seconded. The motion passed unanimously on roll call vote.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Chairman Chamberlain reminded everyone that their Financial Disclosure Statements must be filed by the April 30, 2018 deadline.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to report.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public present.

As there was no more business to come before the Authority, Mr. Piazza moved, and Ms. Napolitani seconded that the meeting be adjourned. All in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:02 p.m.
