In the case that an exhibitor is DQ'd, the following will apply. That entry will count towards the number of horses in the class, but will receive Zero points.

In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by the exhibitor with the most 1st place placing's and so on down the line until the tie is broken. In the event that the tie cannot be broken in the above manner, the senior judge's placing's will be the tie breaker.

All Hi-Points must be picked up at the end of the show. Or make arrangements to have someone pick them up for you. No shipping of awards.
