### 3. **INCLEMENT WEATHER SCHEDULE:**

A contingency plan will be in place in case we have unacceptable weather for outdoor play. We will notify you on this as play progresses and will try to make scheduling decisions that are in the best interest of the players. This may include accelerating play based upon forecasts.

4. **Shoes:** Make sure you have your players wearing non-marking shoes or they will not be allowed to play at the CRFC.

### 5. **LINEUPS:**

- 1) Lineups must be submitted to the head table prior to the playing of the first round. All subsequent rounds will need to be approved by opposing coaches. Lineups will not be revealed until both have been received.
- 2) Lineups must be selected from the 9 member roster submitted to the NDHASAA.
- 3) Substitutions to the original roster maybe made by notifying Katrina Hanenberg prior to the beginning of the Tournament.
- 4) Coaches must place their best singles player in the #1 spot, their best doubles team in the #1 spot, etc....in the lineup submitted for a match.
- 5) Once lineups are submitted, no substitutions maybe made for that round.

6. **AWARDS CEREMONY:** All awards will be presented on Saturday after the conclusion of the Individual competition.
