



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION PROVIDED BY EPCOR

### DEAR CUSTOMER:

We're writing to share information about reclaimed water in use for irrigation at the former Magic Ranch Golf Course.

The owners of the golf course property are using reclaimed water from the Johnson Utilities Section 11 wastewater treatment plant for irrigation, as they did before EPCOR took over management of Johnson Utilities.

Reclaimed water is an important and regulated component of Arizona's total water supply. However, this water is not to the standard appropriate for playing, drinking and washing.

At EPCOR, our top priority is safety. We want to make sure customers and the public are adequately informed about reclaimed water and safe practices around reclaimed water. Because the former golf course is private property, we can't restrict access to it – but we've taken measures to post extra signage around the property noting those safe practices. We also want to share them with you.



In short, adults, children and pets should avoid direct contact with recycled water. In the case of accidental contact, the affected area should be washed with soap and tap water as soon as possible.
