The Pentwater Sportfishing Association (PSA) held "Bannink's End of Summer Lines Down" 11th annual fishing tournament Saturday, August 30th. Twenty-two boats participated and over 1,000 pounds of fish were caught! Cash prizes were awarded and the crew of "Trips to Win" (with captain Bret Almashie) secured the largest King Salmon weighing in at 18.8 pounds. The heaviest trout was a Steelhead weighing 13.9 pounds brought in by "Fish Eagle" (captained by Steve Sauser). The heaviest combination weight (2 salmon and 1 trout) was awarded to "Fish Eagle" as well-with their top three fish weighing 42.8 pounds. The mystery weight category (set at 5.20 pounds) was won by "Ryan's Jule" (captain Ryan Whaley) with a Coho Salmon weighing in at exactly 5.20 pounds. Contestants were allowed to weigh in their top ten fish caught. An additional prize was awarded for the heaviest 10 fish weighed-which went to "Producer" (captain Lyn Snider) with total of 97.1 pounds. All participants received the annual consolation prize towels and agreed it was a great day of fishing.
