Mass Casualty Incident "(MCI) Go Bag" Information

Bags are staged throughout the NCW HERC region:

- **All 16 Emergency Departments**
- 15 Pre-deployable bags for large events (staged with Emergency Management)

Contents located in the center pouch include:

- **10 SOF Tactical Tourniquets**
- **10 Hyfin Vent Chest Seals**
- 10 Quickclot Bleeding Control Dressing 3"x4'



SOF TACTICAL TOURNIQUET INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Unlock the metal clamp loop part from the hook part.



3. Apply tourniquet proximal to the bleeding site, lock the clamp. Pull the band very tight and fasten it.



5. Place the rod inside the clip and lock.



4. Twist the rod until bright red bleeding

2. Insert the band

into the metal clamp

loop part.

7. Secure the rod and band with the strap, adhere it to the opposite hook on the windlass clip.




6. Circle the band over the rod, for extremities, small continue to circle the band around the extremity and over the windlass rod.

HYFIN VENT CHEST SEAL INSTRUCTIONS:



QUIKCLOT BLEEDING CONTROL DRESSING INSTRUCTIONS:



 Open package and remove QuikClot Dressing. Keep the empty package.



2. Place QuikClot Dressing over the wound and use it to apply pressure directly over bleeding source. (more than one dressing may be required.)



3. Continue to apply pressure for 3 minutes or until bleeding stops.



4. Wrap and tie bandage to maintain pressure. Seek medical care immediately. Show product removal directions on package to medical personnel.
