Eligibility	<p>Open to female amateur golfers, 18 years of age or older as of August 11, 2017, who are currently members in good standing of a WGCSC Association listed above, and are the current Gross Champions or Senior Gross Champions of a WGCSC Association Member Club. A Club Championship Gross Runner-Up, who meets the same requirements, may submit an entry ONLY if the Club's Champion is unable to play.</p> <p>A Senior Champion must be 60 years of age or older as of August 11, 2017 and must have won a separate championship at her club set up specifically for Senior Champions. She may not be named Senior Champion strictly because of her age and low score in a regular club championship or any other event.</p> <p>Club Champions and Senior Champions will receive priority. An entry for an eligible Runner-Up will be accepted on a space available basis; based on the earliest postmarked date of entry. Runners-Up will represent their club in the Champion Division.</p> <p>All entrants must have a current, verifiable USGA Handicap Index. The Southern California Masters Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry submitted. See attached WGCSC Conditions and Conduct Policy.</p>
Format/Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 36-Hole Stroke Play @ 100% handicap in two divisions: Champion and Senior. • The field will be limited to 120 players. • Shotgun: 8:00 a.m. both days.
Awards	<p>Equal Gross and Net awards to approximately one-third of the field. The Champion will be the Over-the-Field gross winner from the Champion Division. In the case of a tie for Champion, a playoff will be immediate.</p>
Fees	<p>Club Donation: \$ 70* Fees include two (2) days of golf, shared cart, range use, lunch on Tuesday and</p> <p>Player Fee: <u>\$110</u> tournament fees.</p> <p>Total per Player: \$180 <i>*Minimum club donation is \$70; additional donations will be appreciated.</i></p>

Conditions and Conduct Policy for the Southern California Women's Masters Championship

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION: The WGCSC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry submitted. Any person whose entry is accepted shall be subject to the rules and conditions of play set forth by the WGCSC. Any act of unsportsmanlike conduct, as written in the WGCSC Conduct Policy, will be cause for rejection or removal from a tournament.

WGCSC CONDUCT POLICY: By submitting an entry, or by participating in any WGCSC competition, the player understands that participation is at the sole discretion of the WGCSC. The player's entry may be rejected for any event at the discretion of the official in charge.

Unsportsmanlike conduct or actions at any WGCSC event or WGCSC Association event, state or national event, or conduct or action deemed detrimental to the WGCSC, the spirit of the game or to the host facilities are grounds for such rejection. These include, but are not limited to: cheating; willful destruction of golf course or WGCSC property; abusive language or conduct toward WGCSC and/or host facility, staff, volunteers, or other players; club throwing and/or physical endangerment of others; offensive or excessively loud behavior; repeated withdrawals or no cards during or after completion of a round; failure to register at the assigned location on the day of an event; and repeated disregard of USGA The Rules of Golf Section 1 Etiquette: Behavior on the Course.

Should such an incident occur during a WGCSC event, the official in charge has the right to take appropriate action, including removal of the offending player from the competition, and no refund will be issued. The decision to remove a player during an event by the official in charge is final. Any further action will be up to the WGCSC Board of Directors.
