We can trust God's map for our life.

I. Jesus came to finish course the Father had Mapped out. (plan)

Luke 18:31 "Then He took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things which are written through the prophets about the Son of Man will be accomplished."

- A. All of God's Word must come to pass according to Jesus.
 - 1. Jesus had previously taught all God's words will be fulfilled

 Luke 16:17 "But it is easier for heaven and earth to pass
 away than for one stroke of a letter of the Law to fail."
- B. God's plans to make payment for our sin required the sacrifice of His son. 1 Peter 3:18 "18 For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;"
- II. Jesus revealed the map to His resurrection.
 - A. These details would unfold in a few days.

Luke 18:32 "For He will be handed over to the Gentiles, and will be mocked and mistreated and spit upon, 33 and after they have scourged Him, they will kill Him; and the third day He will rise again."

 - (b) Betrayed by a close friend Ps 41:9
 - 2. Mocked & Spit upon Ps 22:6-8
 - 3. Scourged Is 53:4-5
 - 4. Killed Is 53:8-9
 - 5. Rise again Psalm 16:10

- III. Trust God's Plan even though you may not understand everything fully.
 - A. The disciples focus on immediate glory, blinded them what needed to come beforehand.

Luke 18:34 "But the disciples <u>understood none</u> of these things, and the meaning of this statement <u>was hidden</u> from them, and they <u>did not comprehend</u> the things that were said."

- **1.** They believed that the messiah was going to deliver Israel from their enemies (Roman empire).
- **2.** The two disciple on the road to Emmaus confirmed this belief **Luke 24:21** "But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel...
- **B.** Jesus trusted the father's plan. -After the suffering came the joy!"
 - 1. **Heb 12:2** "... who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."
- C. Our responsibility for today:
 - **1.** Understand God's Map Acts 4:12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.""
 - (a) His word is lamp unto our feet -Psalm 119:105
 - 2. Embrace God's perfect plan for yourself. John 6:40 "For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day.""
 - (a) Can this destiny plan be any more "perfect"?
 - (b) Say to the Lord, "Yes, Jesus, I want to be raised from the dead on last day."
