

Clifford L. Buschlen

Clifford Lee Buschlen, age 68 of Lawrence, Mississippi, passed away on Sunday, June 25 at his home. He was born in Winsor Township on October 29, 1937, son of the late William W. and Edna C. (Gregor) Buschlen, and graduated in 1956 from Pigeon High School. On June 7, 1958 he was united in marriage to Vivian M. Buchholz at Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon.
