"Save the Monarch Butterfly" Sunday, May 19, 2019 1-2 pm at the Eastham Library



The monarch butterfly is in trouble, particularly the eastern migrations, due primarily to loss of milkweed plants. Monarchs lay their eggs only on milkweed plants and the resulting caterpillars only eat their leaves. Without milkweed there are no monarchs. Local ecologist Bill Allan will present a program focusing on what we can do to help the monarchs. Learn about their fascinating life cycle, incredible migration, and actions you can take to help monarchs. There will be free milkweed plants handed out to participants. This program is the first of a 2-part monarch series. The second program on the topic of "raising" monarchs will be presented later in the summer.
