Summer Camp Essentials

For your child's safety this summer, we suggest you send your child with these things:

Late Policy

Please make sure you pick-up your at the class' designated end time. If you are running late for pick-up please call us at 206-473-9580. We have a 5 minute grace period following the end of camp. Then we charge \$1.00 for each minute up to 10 minutes after the grace period. After that time it is \$5.00 if you are later than the initial 10 minutes.

*The first time you are late after the grace period you will receive a written warning. Anytime you are late after that, you will be charged the late fees.

- I agree to follow all Summer Camp rules including those that are not listed on this behavior agreement or rules set forth by my teacher(s) during the camp day.

Seattle's Performers Summer Camp students will be given 3 chances to curb extreme behaviors. After the 3rd write up students will be withdrawn from the program. If behavior is extremely violent, parents may be called and asked to come pick their child up.
