Margeau's House for Women at The Road to Hope

With the help of many, this home offers long-term and structured sober living, and education to women seeking recovery from drugs and alcohol. This expansion in our mission will, too, operate under our belief that every individual, regardless of their circumstances, can achieve lasting sobriety if they are provided with the proper opportunity and environment. Our specific recovery community offers the structure necessary to achieve safe growth, recovery and lasting, uninterrupted sobriety, so difficult to achieve through individual efforts alone.

The Road to Hope believes in the guidance of a Higher Power which has led us to this opportunity to continue and expand our mission. The name Margeau's House was inspired by the story of Margeau Stumphauzer, a young woman who saw the best in everyone but struggled to see her own self worth. Margeau passed away at the young age of 29 but dreamed of helping women to achieve their best life and to embrace their own gifts and talents. Margeau struggled throughout her short life with self destructive decisions but left behind a legacy of love and acceptance. The motto of the project that carries on her life's ambition is "I AM WORTHY" which aligns perfectly with the mission of Road to Hope's "SHARING THE JOURNEY".

Our objective at Margeau's House is to provide women with the opportunity they require to achieve a release from the entrapment of the disease surrounding the abuses of a variety of substances. From the day that they arrive at our front door, they will be welcomed into a community of peers in recovery and be immersed into the process of building a secure foundation for successful recovery. They will receive counseling, friendship, spirituality and guidance toward a new life of sobriety and responsible citizenship.

"Sharing the Journey" is the goal, direction and motto of the Road to Hope.

By launching this outreach and considerable undertaking, we are inspired to honor Margeau's name and memory. We are committed to carrying out her dreams, and those of countless others, by helping women to rise up from their challenges with a new found worthiness, confidence and direction. We have found that new beginnings and a life of change can be best achieved when they are shared with others and driven by love and caring togetherness.
