FOOTBALL TIDBITS

The 25-point loss by 22½ point favorite Tennessee is the 3rd largest loss by a team favored by at least 21 points. The two which were larger: 1999 Arizona State lost by 28 as a 25-point favorite over New Mexico State and 2005 Bowling Green lost by 31 as 25-point favorite over Western Michigan.

The 63 points South Carolina scored on Tennessee are the most by an unranked team against an AP Top-5 opponent in the Poll Era (Since 1936), and the most points allowed by Tennessee vs any opponent since 1893.

Raheim Sanders is the 2nd Arkansas player in the past 25 seasons to have 200 rushing yards and 3 rushing TDs against a ranked opponent in the Razorbacks 42-27 win over #14 Ole Miss. Darren McFadden did that in 2007 in a 50-48 win over #1 LSU.

Georgia is the first SEC team to go undefeated in conference play in consecutive seasons since Alabama in 2008-2009.

TCU's bid for a perfect season stayed alive as Griffin Kell hits a 40-yard game-winning FG as time expired It's the Horned Frogs 4th 11-0 start in program history and first since 2010, when they finished 13-0 and defeated Wisconsin in the Rose Bowl.

Blake Corum found the end zone on the ground for the 18th time this season vs Illinois. Corum is the first player in Michigan program history to rush for a TD in 11 different games in a season.

South Florida QB Byrum Brown threw his first incomplection on his 22nd pass attempt. His 21 consecutive completions to start a game are the most by a starting Football Bowl Subdivision QB since Middle Tennessee State's Brent Stockstill completed 22 straight vs Alabama A&M in 2016.

Miami (FL) had 9 total yards of offense in the first half on Saturday against Clemson. They had the ball for over 9 minutes.

Tennessee scored 66 points vs Missouri and allowed 63 point vs South Carolina just one week later.

USC has 18 interceptions this season, its most in a season since 2012. The last one at UCLA clinched the Trojans' spot in the Pac-12 Championship Game.
