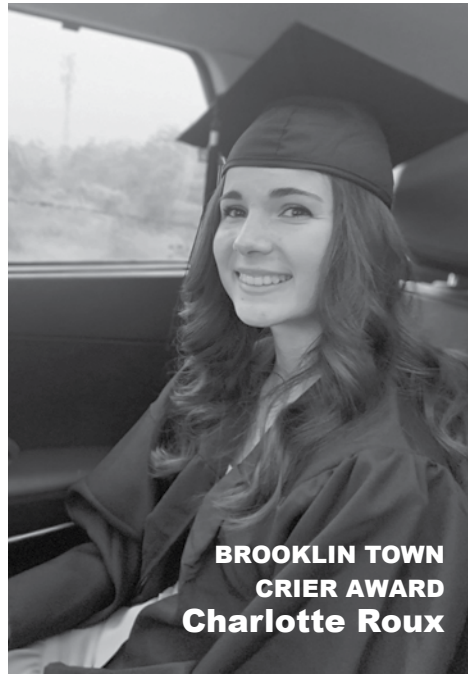

Bronwyn, age 10, and Graydon, 12, make party boxes for special occasions, holidays and birthdays with sweet treats, snacks, toys, decorations, something to wear, and a card. They've been running it for six months.

"We started our business because our parents told us that we spend too much time on our iPads, like it was our job. So we made it our job," explains Graydon.

"We love that we could spread joy throughout COVID by making party boxes especially for birthdays. It's really nice," Bronwyn adds. "We deliver in Brooklin. The best part of our job is we get to taste test the candy. Our biggest challenge is resisting eating too much of our



merchandise."

Their dreams are to continue to help kids in need at SickKids by donating a portion of the proceeds. So far, they've donated over \$250.

The pandemic was a problem in that sales were down dramatically and locations where they



sold were not open. Trying to get supplies when everyone started

learning how to bake during quarantine was also difficult. Plus, the cost of products rose.

"Learning how to work with siblings in a business setting can be challenging at times," says Paige.

The girls believe that the experience of running a business will help in their future careers. Paige wants to become a paediatric doctor. Taylor, who runs the business, has learned how to be responsible while Claire has learned about packaging and baking.

Andrew Cross, age 15, runs a company that specializes in shoe customization. "I buy a plain white shoe and hand paint any designs to support the customer's wants and needs. I mostly paint on an all white Nike Air Force 1 Low, but I have branched out and started painting some Air Jordan shoe models."

He also specializes in cleaning and restoring. If a client has a beat up dirty shoe, he can clean it and even repaint it to look new.

His passion for painting shoes began in March when he came across a beat up pair that he really liked. "I thought that I could maybe fix them so they can look new again." He ended up repainting them and loved the result. He used the left-over paint to try to create a design on a brand new shoe. "My friends and family thought I should try and sell them. I posted a couple of pictures on Etsy and within a couple weeks my business blew up!"

The one thing he loves about painting shoes is that



it's very relaxing. "When I start painting I can focus on the shoes and forget about any stress from school or other problems."

"I have to prioritize my customers' safety by ensuring I follow Covid protocols while handling their merchandise. After finishing painting the shoes, I will disinfect all the items they purchased and let them sit for two days to ensure all bacteria and germs are gone." He protects him-

self by wearing a mask and social distancing as much as possible when dropping off or shipping out shoes.

He hopes to see his brand worn all over the world. "I already ship my shoes all over Canada and the USA, but I think it would be cool to see some merchandise get shipped overseas." Other plans include branching off Etsy and launching his own website. He's been experimenting with making his own clothing and plans to release his designs on his Etsy website by the end of 2021.
