## Town of Stratton Selectmen's Meeting June 8, 2020

**Present:** Selectmen: Al Dupell – Chair, Larry Bills, Chris Liller, Greg Marcucci and Kevin Robinson; and Clerk – Kent Young.

Al Dupell called the meeting to order at 7:30pm at the Stratton Town Hall. Orders were reviewed and signed. No additions to the agenda.

**Road Crew Issues: Little Kidder Brook culvert replacement:** Chris Liller said that easements are not yet complete, but we should have them soon. Signs have been made and should be put into place this week. He will also complete paperwork for the Better Roads Grant, which is for this fiscal year. He said that in discussions with the State, this funding should be available as previously awarded, regardless of the current budget issues due to COVID 19. The culvert is complete, but not yet delivered. The Selectmen reviewed the culvert bill submitted by Fitzpatrick Excavating for \$110,000.00, but which is not to be paid until after July 1, 2020, when the new fiscal year begins. Chris Liller moved to approve said payment. Larry Bills seconded – all concurred. **Rec. Area**: Chris Liller requested permission to purchase signage stating that no motorized vehicle (i.e. dirt bikes or ATVs) with exception of snowmobiles are allowed on Rec Area property off road. He said there have been several recent incidents of these occurrences. The Selectmen concurred.

**COVID 19 Mitigation**: The Clerk asked permission to purchase a laptop computer for use by various Town boards for use to conduct remote meetings. Greg Marcucci moved to approve the request. Chris Liller seconded – all concurred.

**Town Reappraisal**: Kent Young presented a contract submitted by Purvis and Assoc., Stratton's hired assessors, for a town-wide reappraisal scheduled to be completed in 2022, for a total of \$105,000.00. At a recent meeting, the Listers voted to recommend the approval of this contract by the Selectmen. Funds are available and will be increased by 2022, as the State provides funds to the Town each year that are reserved for reappraisals. Chris Liller moved to approve said contract. Larry Bills seconded – all concurred and all signed the contract.

**Minutes:** Chris Liller moved to approve the Selectmen's Minutes and Board of Liquor Control Minutes of May 26, 2020. Larry Bills seconded. The minutes were approved.

Adjourn: Chris Liller motioned to adjourn at 7:50p.m.. Greg Marcucci seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
